

## MINUTES of a Meeting held on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2014 at the Methodist School Room, Reeth

1. Apologies for absence – Councillors OJ Kendall, M Gardner
2. Minutes of last Meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2014, having been circulated were approved and signed.
3. Matters arising
  - 3.1 The spraying at Healaugh can wait until spring when the High Row will need spraying as well
  - 3.2 Light No. 93 is still not working
  - 3.3 The Clerk to approach an arborist to prune the tree opposite the Petrol Pumps.

  1. NYCC – Leader Programme 2014 – 2020- Details handed to Susan Cluderay
  2. NYCC – Bus Winter Time Table has been received. The Clerk to put a copy in the Shelter; but Councillors find the timetables confusing
