




1. Apologies for absence - None
2. Minutes of the last Meetings on 27th April 2015 and 18th May 2015 were circulated, approved and signed.
3. Matters arising - None
4. Correspondence received
 1. £89 2½% Consolidated Stock to be repaid at par on 5th July 2015
 2. "Speeding Concern" – average speed on Arkengarthdale Road 7 days from 6th May 2015 was 29 mph going out and 27 mph coming in. Councillor Beal will raise the matter further with Sgt. Grainger.
 3. A complaint about litter and rubbish on Skelgate Lane should be referred to the National Park Ranger.
 4. Thanks from Mr & Mrs I Pybus for support of planning proposal.
 5. Renault 16 Club re: rally on 16th August 2015 may or may not be taking place.
 6. The Pensions Regulator : The Clerk to be nominated a contact by 30.6.15

 3. Letters to R W Rutter and M Gardner thanking them for their work as Councillors.
 4. Letter to Auditors with Annual Return
6. Memorial Hall accounts were produced and Councillor Beal answered any queries.
7. Insurance had been renewed with Zurich.
8. The Pound (now vacated) is to be advertised to let on an annual basis at an initial rent of



£200 per annum with preference to those people without a garden.

9. Street lights – Nos: 31 (near Chetwynd) & 9 are off. No. 2 is on and off.
10. Yorkshire Water – West Stonesdale water supply. There are now no road closures proposed.
11. The Village Green re:
 1. Seats on the Green – It was proposed by Councillor Beal and seconded by Councillor Bearpark that the Post Office be permitted to position 2 picnic benches where cars cannot park for use by the general public.
 2. Parking on the Green – The Clerk referred to an article by Paul Clayden which implies that parking on the Green is only illegal if it causes damage.
 3. “A” Boards on a Thursday – C Garner to be asked to arrange suitable “A” Boards for display on Thursday nights to prevent parking on the Market area.
 4. Bye Laws – The Council does not want to produce any Bye-Laws. But the “Conditions” agreed with Lord Peel should be looked at.
12. Orton Works – planning application – The Council support the application subject to any comment by local residents.
13. Community Opportunity Fund – “COF” – 2 applications. The Grasscrete at Healaugh has been completed. Councillor Beal to see RDC about the need for another estimate for cobbling at Anvil Square.
