

1. Apologies for absence: Cllr R Beal.
2. Minutes of last Meeting on 28th September 2015 having been circulated, were approved and signed.
3. Matters arising: The Christmas Shopping Evening is to be held on Thursday 26th November 2015.
4. Correspondence received
 - 4.1. A Donation of £138 from GR8 Events towards the cost of a Defibrillator.
 - 4.2. RDC response re: Street lights.
 - 4.3. E-mail re: Roadworks at Bushy Park.
 - 4.4. RAC Rally in the Area 5-8 November.
 - 4.5. Road closure Mill Lane, Reeth – but the drains are still not working!
