

Grinton Parish Council meeting, Monday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2010 at 7.15pm in Grinton Parish Hall.

Present: Chairman Cllr Sunter, Cllrs Coates, Alderson and Porter, the local press reporter and the clerk. Apologies were accepted from Cllr Brown.

Minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

Matters Arising: The gazette have found a cheaper insurance cover, clerk to invoice the cost from renewal date until notice of cancellation.

The Swaledale Festival hope to minimise any inconvenience from parking during the festival fortnight by encouraging the use of parking available in Parks field.

NYCC have acknowledged the Council's comments on their passenger transport review.

The NALC have suggested the Parish Council may consider offering a license to the owners of Corner House and Church View to store one wheelie bin each in the village green. Councillors agreed to put this proposal forward to the homeowners.

Correspondence: As all Councillors do not have access to email, YDNP e-consultations would not be an option.

YDNP Area Ranger James Lamb is leaving, it is hoped to appoint a new ranger by the end of July.

Richmond cycle race grand prix will pass through the Parish on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> August.

NYCC Local Transport Plan consultation draft (summary) questionnaire was left for the clerk to complete.
