- 1. Apologies for absence None
- 2. The minutes were read. After amendment it was proposed by Cllrs DAllinson and RW Rutter that the minutes be approved as a true record and the Chairman signed them as such.
- 3. Matters arising
 - 1. Dr Corbett has met Cllr Allinson about his new seat.
 - 2. Langthorne Drive potholes are to be repaired shortly.
 - 3. The cheque for £47.68 in the minutes included the costs of gifts for Mr J Squires, Sgt Bell and his daughter.

 - 1. William Whitehead addressed the meeting regarding the play area. Playdale have quoted £2726.45 for repairs and replacements of equipment. However Mr Whitehead thinks a saving of £1000 can be made as the RoSPA report does not report any concern with the swings. He will contact Playdale with a view to doing the work himself other than on the aerial swing. He wondered whether an Honesty Box would be appropriate?
 - 2. The Clerk to inform Richard Baker that the mole hills at Healaugh High Green need spreading.
 - 3. The footpath on Arkengarthdale Road near The Buck is often obstructed by parked cars.
 - 4. 2 corner slabs on the Bandstand are loose and need repointing. Some cobbles outside Overton House on the high Row need replacing.
 - 5. Outdoor Centre. The Clerk to check how many signs have been sanctioned.
 - 6. Mill Hill.
