## MINUTES of a Meeting held on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2012

1. There were no apologies for absence.
2. The Minutes of the last Meeting were read approved and signed.
3. Matters Arising.
  - 3.1 The Clerk to arrange a gift voucher for £25.00.
  - 3.2 Two estimates to be sought for dismantling the chimes.
  - 3.3 The Clerk reported that the YDNP are looking at the procedure for registering the footpath near the Copper Kettle on the Definitive Plan.
  - 3.4 A new sign "To the Market Place" is being arranged.
  - 3.5 The car at Healaugh maybe on land belonging to Reeth Moor.
  - 3.6 Dr Corbett is to be asked to contact the approved contractors for a price for the new seat.
4. Correspondence.
  1. Letter of thanks had been received from Black Sheep for the use of the Village Green for the Firkin Challenge which raised £17,000 for Wooden Spoon.
  2. Smith of Derby say the chimes can be looked at if they are disconnected and made available for collection.
  3. Michael Briggs (Area Ranger) – re: new bins which are awaited.
  4. The Clerk to reply to a complaint about the grass not being cut.

11.5 The Clerk to ask David Clark if he can spray the High Row.

11.6 It was agreed that Mr R Tarren can put down some quarry waste at Healaugh on the access to his garage.

11.7 There are loose flagstones near Harker View.

11.8 There is a broken drain in Back Lane.

11.9 Swaledale Festival Banners have not been removed yet.

11.10 There are cracks in Grinton Bridge.

11.11 The Cattle Grid at the Water Splash is filling with rubble.

11.12 The new Library Service will be located at Hudson House.

11.13 The snicket near Mrs Clarkson's bungalow can't be cut back until after the end of the nesting season. Then it will be tarmaced with a rough finish.

11.14 Some grass cutting in Arkengarthdale Road is needed.

11.15 The "Hen" in the playground needs a new spring.
