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MINUTES OF A MEETING held on Monday 24th June 2013

1. There were no apologies for absence.
2. The Minutes of the last Meeting held on 20th May 2013, were read approved and signed.
3. Matters Arising.

The wall adjoining the river at Fremington still needs to be repaired.

4. Correspondence.
 - 4.1 An e-mail from Anthony Millett enquired where the Bus Stop is? The Bus he was waiting for was a "Hail & Stop" service and would stop anywhere. Usually they stop on the High Row on the way up and the Shelter on the way down.

6. Work at the Gents WC has been done.
7. The litter bins have been moved.
8. There was discussion about a Dog Litter bin.
9. Grinton Bridge will need scaffolding for the tree removals.
10. The tree in front of Fremington Bus Shelter needs to be cut back.
11. The height of the grass on the triangle at Downholme Lane end is a road safety hazard.
12. Ivy House bins have been parked on the road.
13. The Clerk to contact a resident about dog fouling.
14. Mrs Maxwell should be requested to contact the Police about people ignoring the "No Parking" sign near the bottom shop.
15. A complaint had been made about verbal abuse when using the path from the Copper Kettle through the Workhouse Garden, alleging trespass. This is not a Public footpath but more a "grace and favour" use.
