

MINUTES OF A MEETING held on Monday 5th August 2013

Present: Councillor OJ Kendall (Chairman), Councillors D Allinson, G Frankland, RW Rutter, & M Gardner, District Councillors B Gale & J Blackie, IC Scott (Clerk) Tracy Little (Press)

1. Apologies for absence were received from Councillor M Bearpark.
2. The Minutes of the last Meeting held on 24th June 2013 having been circulated were approved and signed.
3. Matters Arising.
 - i. The dog bin at the bottom of Mill Hill needs moving.
 - ii. Item 14.9 the scaffolding may be needed for the wall repairs rather than the bridge which will be done with a Cherry Picker.
 - iii. 14.10 Mr Woodward to be asked to do the work
4. Correspondence.
 1. Invitation to attend the opening of the Nutmeg Gallery, Unit 14 Silver Street, on 2nd August 2013.
 2. Npower is to increase its tariff prices by 15%. The Clerk is to make enquiries elsewhere.
 3. Inspector Geoff Crocker (Police) with his contact details.
 4. £78.96 received from NYCC for grass cutting. There should be extra for dealing with Arkengarthdale Road.
 5. RDC – Children's Play Improvement Fund 2013/14. £2000 per application to be made by 1st November 2013.
5. War Memorial – update. The Clerk is contacting Colonel Le Mesurier.
6. Tour de France. It was decided to hold a Public meeting prior to the next meeting. Swaledale will be the most Northerly point at which the race has taken place. Some Councils are arranging large banners and leaflets.
7. Memorial Hall – The accounts were produced.
8. Tenders for Works.

14. Any other business.

1. Repairs to the Reeth – Richmond road will start in late September or early October at a cost of £1.5m.
2. The Mobile Skip will be back on 2 November 2013.
3. Councillor Allinson handed the Clerk a note of street lights which were not working so that the Council can be informed.
4. There is a hole in the cobbles near the wood blocks at Half Moon. Highways to be informed.
5. The blocked drain opposite the Temperance has not yet been fixed.
6. Mrs Parker has had a site visit and a location on Arkengarthdale Road has been agreed. The Clerk to request £50.
7. Mrs Heaton wishes to have a Turnberry Bench. She should be asked to contact Councillor Allinson.
8. The Silver Street sign is still missing.
9. Meg Squires should be referred to the Athletic Club about the Playing Field gates being closed. The Clerk to obtain copies of the Deeds if possible.
10. Councillor Gale has referred the cutting and surfacing of the Snicket to NYCC.
11. The Museum has been awarded funding.
12. Comment was made about the state of Grinton Cemetery.
13. Skelgate Lane needs cutting back.
14. Councillor Gardner expressed his thanks on behalf of Healaugh residents for the work done by Councillors Allinson & Frankland to the seats at Healaugh.
15. Healaugh Bottom Green needs spraying.
16. Footpath up the School Hill. C Woodward to be asked to attend to it.
