

MINUTES OF A MEETING held on Friday 20th September 2013

Present: Councillors OJ Kendall (Chairman) M Gardner G Frankland D Allinson & RW Rutter, IC Scott (Clerk) Mrs T Little (Press) & 16 members of the public.

1. Apologies for absence. Councillor M Bearpark.
2. A PUBLIC MEETING to consider the Tour de France was held. It was agreed that the central part of the Village Green needs to be fenced off and that the organisation of events be left to the Committee already established for that purpose.
3. Minutes of the last Meeting held on 5th August 2013 having been circulated were approved and signed.
4. Correspondence had been received from:
 1. NYCC proposed reductions to bus service subsidy. There is to be a public meeting to discuss the proposals.
 2. RDC reminder that applications for the area partnership funding scheme close on Tuesday 1st October 2013.
 3. St John's Community Centre asking for financial help.
 4. Email from Mr & Mrs Stocks RE: Cutting of grass at Fremington. The Clerk to establish what the NYCC regard as a highway verge.
5. NPower Contract has been renewed on a better tariff. A direct debit was signed.
6. Tenders for Works. It was agreed to accept Tony Sunter's estimate for the Bandstand repairs and Phoenix estimate for the Shelter and roadside wall repairs. The Clerk to apply for Grant funding.
7. Playground. Playdale Proposal for replacing the Spring Chicken at a cost of £788.50 was agreed. The Clerk to submit an application for grant funding.
8. A Resolution to pay the following was passed:

 7. There is a cracked top stone on Reeth Bridge.
