1. Apologies for absence.

3.4 The dead Elm and the saplings have been cut.


3.5 The Clerk to ring Yorkshire Water re: the water at Cambridge House.

4. Correspondence.

1. Alicja Pottley of Richmond is hoping to occupy the old workshop next to Swaledale Outdoors, Bagshaw's Yard as a café (subject to planning). She would like to place some signs near the yard and on the Green. It was decided to wait until planning permission has been granted. But the proliferations of signs may need controlling by arranging for one pole with directions for the different businesses.

14. Public Meeting re: Bus Timetables.


Following the meeting alternative times have been proposed. The last bus from Richmond needs to be 6pm not 4pm.
