MINUTES of a Meeting held on Monday 27th January 2014 at Methodist School Room, Reeth

Present: Councillors M Bearpark (Chairman) M Gardner, G Frankland, RW Rutter, OJ Kendall, IC Scott (Clerk) Mrs T Little (Press) and one member of the public.

- 1. Apologies for absence were received from Councillor D Allinson.
- 2. The Minutes of the last Meeting held on 2nd December 2013 had been circulated and it was proposed by Councillor Kendall, seconded by Councillor Rutter and resolved that the Minutes be approved and they were duly signed.
- 3. Matters arising.
 - 1. It was suggested that a Byelaw be considered at the next meeting to ban dogs from the Village Green to prevent dog fouling.
 - 2. It was commented that Phoenix had done a good job on the wall near the War Memorial.
 - 3. The RDC Communities Opportunities Fund may provide grant assistance with work to the War Memorial.
 - 4. Harkers Coaches planning application had been refused.
 - 5. Bus Services. It will be proposed that there be 5 bus services a day Richmond to Reeth and back with a "Ring to Ride" service to Keld.
- 4. Correspondence.
 - 4.1 Richmondshire District Council have approved the Playground Improvement Application. An order has now been placed.
 - 4.2 YDNP re: removal of trees at Highfields, Back Lane, Reeth, Irongate Plantation, Fremington and Draycott Hall.
 - 4.3 Citizens Advice Bureau seeking a donation. But none was proposed.
 - 4.4 YDNP It was decided that the Council do not need a visit from a member other than Councillor Gardner.
 - 4.5 Mrs M Ogilvie re: signs to the playground. It may be that the Communities Opportunity Fund could fund some signs.
 - 4.6 Cancer Research thanks for donation.

- 4.7 Letters to The Kings Arms. In view of the fact that the beer kegs and other items are still in the Mews, it was agreed that the Clerk refer the matter to Solicitors to take Court action. The area is a public footpath, wall to wall. The wheelie bins could go into the yard at the rear of the premises if the gate is widened.
- 4.8 SWAAG Invitation to launch event the big dig Thursday 13th March 7pm in the Memorial Hall.
- 4.9 RAC Endurance Rally, The Flying Scotsman 4.4.14 to 6.4.14 only passes through a portion of Reeth Moor.

- 7. It is proposed that the flag be flown at half mast on 1st February 2014 in remembrance of Stanley Bayles who has died.
- 8. There is a large quantity of rubbish outside Ivy Cottage.
- 9. The Street Light No. 92 on the corner is not working.
