Competition It was agreed to enter Grinton in Richmondshire's 2008 Best Kept Village Competition, Cattle Grid Recent repairs to the cattle grid on the moor road had failed and it had silted up again, allowing sheep to cross and causing a hazard on the road. This had already been reported to Highways by a member of the public and the council would send a supporting letter. It was noted that many comments had been received on difficulties caused by the 21 day time limit, however that was out of the hands the local department and was a response to central Little 01748 884 759.

Inspectors visited both sites on January 18th and detailed reports have been produced which are the result of rigorous evaluation of the many aspects school effectiveness including. "leadership and management", "teaching and learning" and "standards and achievement". Governors are delighted that both Reeth and Gunnerside were judged to be good schools by the inspectors who found teaching and learning to be good overall. Inspectors also reported that teachers know pupils very well and that pupils have positive attitudes to learning. To improve further, the confederation is advised to ensure that more able pupils are challenged sufficiently and that all pupils are made aware of their own learning targets and of how to use them improve their work. Commenting on the outcome of the inspections, acting headteacher, Vivienne Smith said, 'I feel privileged to have been linked with the inspection of this unique confederation. It is a fitting tribute that the hard work of the children and everyone involved with the schools has been recognised in this way.'

Some of the blind people we have taught previously earned a living through begging: The Gambian government has banned begging, leaving these people with no income at all. By teaching them to make rugs from readily-available, lowcost recycled fabrics. Rug Aid is helping them to regain their independence and to experience the joy I get from the wonderful creative activity of rag rug making. 

Dear Sir, I am interested in anything to do with analing in the Yorkshire Dales. particularly during the nineteenth century. Although there is alot of information on Wharfedale and Wensleydale, there is very little on Swaledale. Herbert Palmer, in his book 'The Roving Angler'(1933) has a chapter on the Swale and mentions noted local anglers such as George Dunn and Mr Bullock of Gunnerside and Mr Redmond of Low Row. T K Wilson (Broughton Point) of Skipton was a prolific writer on analing matters and in 'The Dalesman' 'Yorkshire Illustrated' he mentions a Ralph Ward of Reeth who was the local postman and a very good angler and fly tyer . Wilson states that Ward used a leather creel or pannier and that the local cobbler made them. They were also much used in the Hawes area the maker in that area being Atkinsons of Sedbergh. These panniers stop being made around the turn of the twentieth century. If anyone has any information on old anglers or fly patterns I would be delighted to hear from them. 



I would rather see them lose 6-3 and score some goals than lose 2-0 with no goals! We have now resumed training for the Under 8's on Sundays at Reeth 12,30 - 1,30. New players are very welcome (boys and girls) as indeed they are at any age group up to 16. We are very stretched organising matches particularly at home and any volunteers for such jobs as putting up goals, marking the pitch and generally helping to keep the club going would be very welcome. There are usually just 2 of us to get ready and we are often at different venues!! You will have read that we have obtained planning permission for new facilities at Reeth and in this connection I would like to convey very many thanks to John Blackie for all his help. We are very sorry to hear of his illness and wish him all the very best. There is still a very long way to go to get the project off the ground (literally in view of the flood precautions). There will be much fundraising after a lull and parents will be expected to rally round. One likely project will be a 300 Club and I would hope we can go a long way towards 300 participants in our Club alone.
