REETH SURGERY IMPORTANT PATIENT NOTICE

Reeth Surgery will be implementing an **evening** appointment system from the 1^{st} October.

Evening surgery with the doctor will run from 4pm to 6pm on Monday, Wednesday and Friday with appointments at 10-minute intervals.

Appointments can be booked in advance or on the day either by telephone (884396) or in person.

The morning surgeries will continue to be open access from 8:30am to 10am.

The reasons for this change are to make it easier for working people to see the doctor and also allow us to have later opening times during the week in the near future.

We will still have flexibility to deal with emergencies arising during the day.

Many of our patients have commented in our satisfaction surveys that they would prefer an appointment system, so that they do not have the unpredictability of the open access surgery and also potentially a long wait. Working patients are also keen to have longer surgery hours so that they can see the doctor after work. An appointment system in the evening would enable us to provide this service more easily. The doctor usually

sees 12 patients during the evening clinic, so extending the new evening surgery times should ensure no reduction in service.

'Flu vaccination clinic' will be held on Friday 10th. October at the Quaker Close Flats between 11.30 and 15.30. Patients over 65, those with chronic diseases such heart disease, respiratory disease, kidney disease, diabetes and carers are entitled to vaccination. No appointment is necessary

Election of National Park Authority Members

Consultations are underway to find out what people think about the idea of directly electing some members of the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority (YDNPA).

Under the current system, members of the nine national parks in England are appointed by county or district councils or by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

The Government is now asking its stakeholders to explore whether directly-elected members would aid or hinder the performance and the running of national park authorities.

Local MPs David Curry (Skipton and Ripon), William Hague (Richmond) and Tim Farron (Westmorland and Lonsdale) and county and district councils that cover the Yorkshire Dales National Park are among those being asked for their views. Details of the proposals can be found on the website of the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs at www.defra.gov.uk/corporate/consult/np-directelections/index.

A spokesman for the YDNPA said: "The issue will be discussed at the September meeting of the National Park Authority where we will determine our own position on the consultation."

The closing date for comments is Friday 28 November.

VIP visit to National Park

Jonathan Shaw, Under Secretary of State at Defra for Marine, Landscape and Rural Affairs, paid a day-long, factfinding visit to the National Park

yesterday (September 11).

The MP met Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority (YDNPA) officers and Deputy Chairman Harold Brown before being shown round the former quarry at Craven Limeworks where he learned about plans for its re-development.

He then went to nearby Langcliffe Mill in Stainforth Road, Langcliffe, and inspected plans for the building - which include construction of offices and a 46-bedroom hotel - and discussed wider economic development issues in a rural/protected area.

Mr Shaw also sampled the delights of part of the Pennine Bridleway National Trail when he and his hosts jumped on mountain bikes to ride over to the Gamecock pub in Austwick for lunch.

David Butterworth, the YDNPA's Chief Executive, said: "It is always useful to get a Government Minister into the National Park. He was interested in a wide variety of issues - the future of hill farming, our response to the issues connected with climate change, affordable housing and, in particular, how to balance the needs of conservation and economic development in a protected area"

Issued by the RSPB and Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority PEREGRINES RULE THE ROOST

Peregrine falcons once again held centre stage in the Yorkshire Dales National Park this year - attracting an audience of thousands. Despite poor weather conditions this summer more than 21,000 people - including about 6,000 children - took advantage of a special, free Falcon Watch viewpoint set up by the RSPB and the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority (YDNPA) at Malham Cove to watch the birds through powerful telescopes. Ian Court, the species officer said: "For the second year running the peregrines did their bit by fledging two young which, after the terrible weather and heavy rain this year, were named Splish and Splash. "The newest arrivals are good news for the peregrine population in the Dales and the visitor numbers show just how interested people are in them.

Matthew Capper, the RSPB's People Engagement Officer, said: "The viewpoint is manned by a team of RSPB and National Park staff and volunteers and its success is down to their enthusiasm and drive.

"They put in the equivalent of nearly 400 volunteer days between them in all weathers, passing on their knowledge about the peregrines to the visitors.

"We would also like to thank the people of Malham for their support once again."

The Malham Falcon Watch is part of the RSPB's *Aren't Birds Brilliant!* programme of events, which make rare and spectacular birds accessible for everyone

to see. As well as the peregrines, visitors to Malham were able to see green woodpeckers, little owls, redstarts and cliff-nesting house martins.

"Sadly, birds of prey such as peregrine falcons still face illegal persecution. This is an unacceptable situation and the RSPB is calling for an end to illegal killing of birds of prey," Matthew said.

The RSPB is asking members of the public who care about our birds of prey, such as the Malham peregrines, to pledge their support for an end to illegal killing at www.rspb.org.uk/birdsofprey.

PEREGRINE FALCON FACT FILE

The peregrine is the largest of British breeding falcons. It is 38-48 cm long, and its wingspan is 95-110 cm. The female is considerably larger than the male. The upper parts are dark bluegrey, and the under parts are pale with fine, dark bars. The head has a black 'hood' with black moustache-like markings on the face. Juvenile birds are browner and heavily streaked below Peregrines typically pair for several years and may live up to 10 years old - the oldest on record was 15 years and 6 months old

Both adult birds tend the young, which take their first flight after 5 or 6 weeks Peregrines feed on medium sized birds, which they catch in high-speed aerial stoops - although more often than not they fail to make a kill/

Peregrine numbers crashed in the 1960's due to the impact of pesticides. Peregrines have now increased in numbers, to about 1,300 breeding pairs in the UK. Around 20 pairs of peregrines nest in the Yorkshire Dales National Park.




