Crime in the two Dales

On behalf of North Yorkshire Police I would like to wish you all a prosperous and happy New Year.

During the last few months there have been 10 incidents relating to the theft of quad bikes across the Dales including Low Row and Arkengarthdale and four persons have been arrested in connection with this type of offence. The quads can be loaded into vans as well as driven off along the roads. Any suspicious vehicles and persons are investigated but it is essential to get the vehicle registration marks, as well as reporting the incident/s Immediately on 0845-60-60-247. this will then give more time for a deployed officer to reach the location concerned.

If there are reports of adverse weather conditions we strongly recommend that individuals avoid hazardous routes and try to pick an alternative route that is safer simply turn around rather than continuing. Working with Richmondshire Community Safety Partnership includes the Fire Brigade, Dale and Vale and the Youth Council, we are hoping to attend, coffee mornings or luncheon clubs to promote safety and home security. Anyone interested in all the partners attending a full event or just wanting us to stay in the background with stalls, please contact myself via Hudson House or leave a message at Leyburn Police station. During the next few weeks I will be distributing some Information packs relating to the afore mentioned partners which will be made available to everyone. 'How Pleasant to Know Edward Lear'

Edward Lear first attracted attention by his paintings of birds and later turned to landscapes producing watercolours of great delicacy. He travelled to Greece, Italy, Egypt and India and published books on his travels with his own illustrations. His Book of Nonsense, which popularised the limerick, has never been out of print since its first appearnce in 1846. This warm and delightful person - 'A man of original and versatile genius' - an ornithologist, diarist, musician and traveller expressed his simple philosophy through timeless humour. In the Wensleydale Decorative and Fine Arts lecture, at Middleham Key Centre on Tuesday 10 February at 2.00pm, Tim Stimson focuses on the life of Edward Lear with illustrations of his work and quotations from his writings. A painter and ceramicist, Tim has spent the past 15 years as as a freelance Art Historian specialising in 17th and 19th century art and society. He lectures for the universities of Hull and Cambridge and for NADFAS and presents residential study courses in Britain and Europe.





Time Team in the Yorkshire Dales

TV archaeologists have been busy in the Yorkshire Dales National Park digging up history about the Settle Carlisle railway. Presenter Tony Robinson and the Channel 4 Time Team spent three days with Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority Senior Conservation Officer Robert White investigating the site of one of the construction camps set up to house the

Their findings from the camp near Dent Station will be screened on Sunday (February 1) in a programme called 'Blood, Sweat and Beers'.

workers who built the railway.

The investigations centred on construction camp 2, which was a group of five huts that housed some of the workers and their families who built the Risehill Tunnel north of Dent Station - the second longest tunnel on the railway - between 1869 and 1875. Occupations recorded in the 1871 census included a carpenter, two blacksmiths and stone masons as well as railway miners.

"Although we know a little bit about the construction of the Settle Carlisle Railway, we had very little knowledge of the actual process and the living conditions of the people who built it," Robert said.

"At Ribblehead we have had the camp surveyed and done some excavation but the site the Time Team looked at was the type we know very little about.

"The Risehill camp was on top of a hill in the middle of a peat bog. The excavations showed just how harsh their living conditions were and helped give an idea of the scale of the machinery that was used to help build the tunnel."

The End Of An Era In Arkengarthdale

"Which way is Bilsdale?" asked the guy installing our new TV aerial as he tried to line up the aerial towards the transmitter. "It's been moved to the top of that Scots Pine tree behind the Corn Mill, courtesy of the Arkenqarthdale Television Committee", we pointed out, and explained that because of the local terrain and the sparse population we had to rely on "a self-help relay system" to boost the signal from the Bilsdale transmitter.

The Arkengarthdale TV Self-help Scheme "went live" in 1982, to bring terrestrial television reception to a swathe of the dale roughly from High Green to CB Yard and Eskeleth, A scheme had been planned during 1981, with Lord Arundel (as then) and Gordon Newcombe instrumental in getting the necessary Planning Consent from the National Park and the Licence Approval from the Home Office. There were originally 31 members of the "dub", which was managed by a small committee. This had Parkin Waller as Chairman (after Gordon Newcombe moved away), George Birks as Treasurer and John Hird as Secretary. The number of subscribers to the scheme eventually reached 50, but has decreased now to around half-a-dozen, as satellite dishes have taken over.

The scheme uses an UHF Receiver up on Bouldershaw Moor, which is connected by a cable to the "active deflector aerials" mounted on the fir tree behind the Corn Mill. An electricity supply from Jocelyn Campbell's house has provided the necessary power since the inception of the scheme. The equipment was installed by

Mr. K.S. Sayer of Kirkby Stephen and Mr. Saver's firm has continued to excellent service in maintaining repairing the equipment ever since. The last major repair followed a lightning strike in spring 2002 which blacked out the final episode of an Auf Wiedersehen Pet series. (when Middlesbrough's Transporter Bridge was rebuilt in the USA). much to Duncan Campbell's disappointment.

Annual running costs for the scheme (paid for by members' subscriptions) currently average around £200 per annum for the electricity, the Relay Licence and minor repairs. Additional sums are drawn from users when needed for major repairs. Of course, no allowance is made against the cost of the TV licence which everyone has to pay.

However, the days of the scheme are numbered - the pine tree is dead, so access to the reflector aerials is not possible. Thus if the current system were to fail, a new analogue system would have to be installed, costing around £2,500, and with the switch to digital TV in 2012, a different system and a further £2,500 would be needed, With only half-a-dozen users and funds depleted, costs to individuals would be far higher than the £150 needed to install a Freesat satellite aerial.

So the 27 year old scheme will cease to operate when the current licence expires on 12th February 2009. Our thanks are particularly due to those who have managed the scheme over its lifetime, George Birks, Parkin Waller and the late John Hird. Also to those who worked to obtain the original permission, the Duke of

NEW LEASE OF LIFE FOR 'GREEN LANE'

A rutted, ankle-twisting 'green lane' west of Hawes is open for business again after being transformed by the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority (YDNPA).

The route at Cotter End - known locally as The Highway or the Lady Anne Highway - is ready for visitors at the end of a yearlong project that has seen it stripped down to its basics and virtually rebuilt.

And, after years as a Byway Open to All Traffic (BOAT), access is now restricted to walkers, horse riders and mountain bikers.

Matt Neale, the YNDPA's Area Ranger for Upper Wensleydale, said: "As a BOAT, it had been used a lot by off-road motor vehicles - mainly motorbikes - and it was in a terrible condition, with ruts across its width, some almost waist deep. The condition was made worse by poor drainage.

"It was dangerous for horses and we had a lot of complaints from walkers because you could easily twist your ankle.

"We have rebuilt the path and improved the drainage along the whole section, which is just over a kilometre long, and, due to the sensitive nature of the route, we have introduced a Traffic Regulation Order,

"Now it is much easier to use and people will be able to enjoy the views as they travel along it instead of having to look down all the time and concentrate on where they put their feet."

Landowner Sandra Facer said: "The work by the National Park Authority has transformed it completely. It's a huge improvement on what it was a year ago and the TRO will mean it should stay in this condition for a long time."

Historically the route was used by horses and carts for many years as the main road from Hawes to Kirkby Stephen and by Lady Anne Clifford on her regular travels between Skipton and Brough.

She was born at Skipton Castle in 1590, the third and only surviving child of George Clifford, third Earl of Cumberland, and his wife Margaret Russell.

She finally inherited the estate in 1643.and spent the next 26 years rebuilding almshouses, churches and castles including Skipton, Pendragon, Appleby, Brough and Brougham, where she finally died in 1676.




