"DO SOMETHING DIFFERENT"?!

Great fun was had by all as children and their families gathered for an action packed afternoon of maths activities. On Friday 14th November all children from Reeth Community and Gunnerside Methodist Confederated Primary Schools came together to "Do Something Different" for Children in Need. The children took part in various activities throughout the day - they came to school in their own clothes, four of the children were chosen to be a shadow Head Teacher, Foundation and Key stage 1 children attempted to draw a picture using only their feet, Years 3 and 4 made biscuits and years 5 and 6 played "Call my Bluff" as an alternative way of learning spellings. Staff organised a maths challenge afternoon for the children but also invited parents and carers to attend and become pupils again. The purpose of the afternoon was to show parents some of the ranges of activities the children do at school to help them develop their mathematical skills. As well as taking part in the activities, the parents were able to talk to a consultant from North Yorkshire Children and Young People's Service who shared examples of up to date teaching methods and offered advice on how to help at home. "I am really pleased to see so many parents here", said Mrs Bastow, Acting Headteacher. "Everyone seems to be having a great time. I hope the parents have found it useful and will go away with a clearer view of what maths is all about and how they can help their children with it at home". In October last year this long record of serving beer to the thirsty folk of Swaledale seemed close to coming to an As a result of dwindling custom. stocks were depleted (there was only 3 days stock of beer in the cellar) and "last orders" were about to be called for the last time. Rather than let this historic pub close; taking away another facility in the village, the villagers rallied together and approached a local company to see if a short term rescue plan could be put into place.

With the support of the owner of the building, Upperswale Limited has taken on a short term lease of the pub with a pledge to try and keep the facility open and improve the services offered. The villagers of Gunnerside recognised that this venture would only be successful with the help and support of the community.

In November last year a group of committed villagers spent a week cleaning and painting the pub - making a dramatic difference to the interior. Some readers may have seen feature on this on Tyne Tees TV news. Over the next few months a number of "volunteer bar staff" will work alongside paid staff until the pub returns to profitability. The King's Head is now regaining its place as a thriving village pub. The whole pub has been cleaned, minor building improvements made and redecoration has made it a relaxing environment for a quiet lunch or evening Home cooked food is available drink. lunch times and evenings between Tuesday

Rescue saves the Kings Head, Gunnerside and Sunday (the kitchen is closed on The King's Head in Gunnerside started Mondays).

In recognition of the role the village played in restoring the pub the King's Head will ensure that service to the community remains at the heart of the pub. Wireless internet is now available free of charge; with a computer available in the bar for community use. Over the next few weeks there are plans to open a shop facility; so villagers and tourists can purchase basics such as bread and milk.

The King's Head is not only open for business but leading the way in establishing the services a local village pub should offer in 2009.

SPORTS PROJECT PROGRESS

Many people have asked how the proposed new pavilion and MUGA are progressing. Why not come along to Hudson House on 30th January and see for yourselves how things are going? Derek Pollard, Project Manager, and at least one other committee member will be there to answer your questions. Farm buildings under the microscope

Traditional farm buildings are to be put under the spotlight in the first survey of its kind to be undertaken in the Yorkshire Dales National Park.

Thousands of buildings, ranging from sheep shelters to hay barns, will be mapped, measured and photographed in a new census launched by the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority (YDNPA) this week. The first phase will be a six-month pilot in the Swaledale, upper-Wharfedale and Ingleton areas to work out the best way of carrying out the study, according to Authority's **Assistant** Building Conservation Officer Don McLellan . "It is thought there may be as many as 6,000 traditional farm buildings within the National Park but, because no-one has ever attempted such an extensive exercise using volunteers before, there is no proven methodology - which is why we need the pilot study." he said. Once the methodology has been worked out, the real work will begin - and could last a number of years. Don said the condition of the National Park's traditional farm buildings

was deteriorating steadily and the trend was only likely to be reversed if new funding could be brought on line and made available to farmers and landholders. "In order to have accurate information for future bids, a comprehensive survey of this nationally-important barns landscape is needed," he said. "We have recruited volunteers from the local communities to carry out the work and, as well as counting how many traditional farm buildings there are, we are hoping to gather some architectural information to help us better understand the nature of the farm building resource. "For example, we hope to find out what the original purpose of each building might have been - a hogg house for sheep, a stable and a hay barn are the main types that we expect to find - but there will also be examples of buildings that were once in domestic use "To this intend end to collect diaital photographs as well as sketch plans and basic measurements for each building recorded. "The Dales field barn landscape is of European significance and the results of the survey will be used to lobby for





Appeal to ease affordable housing shortage Landowners in the Yorkshire Dales National Park are being given the chance to put forward sites that could be used to ease demand for affordable housing. The Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority (YDNPA) is asking residents to suggest areas that could be built on in an effort to create more housing for local need. An appeal for sites was launched today (January 5), with members of Parish Councils and Parish Meetings being asked to put on their thinking caps and to talk to local landowners. Yvonne Peacock. Chair of the YDNPA's Housing Working Group and Planning Policy Champion said: "The lack of affordable housing in the Yorkshire Dales National Park is something the Authority recognises as a serious problem. "There is an urgent need to build more homes so that local people can stay instead of being forced out of the National Park because of high house prices. "We are relying on the landowners to help us to ease the problem." Peter Stockton, the YDNPA's Strategic Planning Officer, said: "The National Park has a substantial shortfall of affordable housing and the aim of this appeal is to establish a good range of new sites to choose. Once we have done that, we can allocate the most appropriate sites to help reduce the shortfall." Landowners are being asked to submit sites within the next eight weeks, with a closing date of noon on Friday, February 27th. Details of how to submit a site are available on the Authority's website at www.yorkshiredales.org.uk. After the closing date, a list of all the submitted sites will be published and members of the public will be given six weeks in which to comment on their suitability.

Those comments, together with all the relevant planning considerations, will then be used by a working group to draw up a shortlist of the best sites to present to the Authority. That list will then be published in a draft Housing Development Plan document that will go out for a six-week period of consultation. A final version incorporating any further amendments will then be published and examined by a Planning Inspector at a public hearing.

Marrick Parish Council Meeting 27 November 2008.

Refuse & Kerbside Recycling Schemes Richmondshire District Council bluow undertaking a review of the implementation of the final phase of the introduction of these schemes on 13 January 2009. Comments would be forwarded for inclusion. It was considered better consultation in the first place would have prevented many of the problems. The 'lane -end' policy caused difficulties for some residents. Reports of bins blowing on to the road had been received. There were concerns that these could cause accidents. Councillor Wilhelmy had written to the District Council several months ago and the Clerk had also been in contact. Some of the problems had been resolved. However, it was considered that worsening weather conditions would exacerbate Environmental Matters A proposal was being developed by Nidderdale AONB, YDNPA and Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust to help parishes within the LEADER area to enlist 'parish caretakers' to carry out a range of practical small-scale works. It would be a competitive process as funding would be limited. The parish would receive a grant towards the cost, the balance to be met from parish funds. It was agreed no application would be made. CPRE had forwarded a toolkit sponsored by Keep Britain Tidy as part of their anti-litter campaign. Facts showed the amount of litter in public spaces and the countryside was growing and was thought by many people to the worst thing about their environment. It was estimated 25 million tonnes was dropped each year, costing local authorities more than half a billion pounds to clear up. Councillor Stones requested that Highways again be reminded of the need for repairs to road edges. Councillor Richardson remarked on the difficulty some medical teams were experiencing in finding addresses in the parish.

Councillor Blackie would be informed. North Yorkshire County Council Council Plan and Budget Having discussed the consultation document at some length, focussing on the council priorities, budget process, value for money and council tax, it was agreed no further comments would be forwarded. Financial Regulations Review Following a proposal from Councillor Hodgson, seconded by Councillor Wilhelmy, it was resolved to adopt the Financial Regulations, which included a minor addition of clarification. Internal Audit The Internal Auditor had examined the accounts on 14 November 2008. He confirmed all financial documents were correct. Councillors received copies οf his half-yearly report. Correspondence The Final Report on the Scrutiny Review into Out of Hours Services in Richmondshire had been received. Councillors were in agreement with the recommendations. North Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Authority Corporate Report 2008-11 envisaged working more closely with Parish and District Councils over the next year, to deliver services to meet the needs of local communities. After studying the consultation paper on Codes of Conduct for local authority members and employees, no comments were considered necessary. The Clerk understood a new model Publication Scheme was to be introduced under the Freedom of Information Act, but no official information had, as yet, been received. The Parish Council already had a scheme in place, which could be amended, should this be found to be necessary. The Clerk had attended the Energy Saving Advice drop-in session at Reeth on 7 November, where information could be obtained on saving energy and reducing fuel costs. The official launch of the Two Dales Live Video Link at Marrick had taken place on 13 November. Date of next meeting 15 January 2009 at 7.30p.m.at Marrick Institute.






