

'Wheels 2 Work' is a moped leasing scheme aimed at helping people get over the initial problem of getting to work or training where no suitable alternative transport exists. Conditions of eligibility for the scheme are:

Applicant must live in the Hambleton or Richmondshire Districts Applicant must be aged 16+

Require transport to enable them to travel to employment, training, education or job seeking.

The daily journey must be a practical distance for a moped

We have had record numbers to see the wonderful Embroidery exhibition, and huge thanks to members of the Richmond and Leyburn Embroiderers' Guild who stewarded, and those of you who came to see the display. We hope to further develop our links with the Guild, so watch this space for new developments.

SATURDAY 11th July sees our 3rd Annual POETRY DAY and launch of the book of the previous two year's events. Tracey Ball will read her poems on the Dales, delightful and debonair Dominic Goodwin will be here again for his request hour when you choose which poems he reads, and our open reading session from you our local poets, this year on the theme of 'Music and the Dales'. All this and lunch for £10, including a copy of the new poetry book! Contact Helen to secure your place!

Our first 'CONVERSATION IN CRAFT' begins on Saturday 25th July, at 7.30 in the Museum with PETER CUMMINGS. Your chance to ask questions and convivial explore his work. in а atmosphere with light refreshments. Tickets £4. The second 'Conversation' is with JENNY DAVIES on Saturday 8th August. Come and support your local craftsmen and women and find out what makes them tick!

At the moment we are working on new panels on CHERT quarrying, COAL mining, and FAMILY HISTORY, as well as a map of the key archaeological and mining sites in Swaledale and Arkengarthdale. These have been made possible thanks to a grant from the Northern Mines Research Society and the design and production skills of Scenic View Gallery in Reeth On Wednesday 8 July the Friends of the Museum talk will be a special event, our first Jill Curry Memorial Lecture. Given by Tim Laurie it will be at 7.30pm in the Museum on 'Archaeological Landscapes in Swaledale'. Our August talk on 12th will be'The Bus Up the Dale - The Story of Percivals' by Reuben Frankau who is researching and writing a book on the subject. Don't forget that our WALKs begin this month too. On Monday 6th July Mining in Gunnerside Gill. Roger Pettican will lead a visit to the extensive remains of what was once a large and important lead mining area, including Sir Francis and Bunton levels and their associated dressing floors, the Bunton and Great North Hush and the Lownathwaite mines. Meet in the car park at Gunnerside at 2pm. On Monday 20th July Lead Mining in Wensleydale. A moderate 4 mile (6.4 km.) walk looking at the mining industries of Wensleydale and the associated geology, in the area around historic Castle Bolton. ### 350TH. ANNIVERSARY.

Last Saturday I had the very great pleasure of attending the start of the 350th Anniversary Celebrations for Arkengarthdale CE School. It is really quite fantastic to think that that school has been serving our community since 1659 when Oliver Cromwell's son Richard was leader of our country, or the Commonwealth as i t was known. Arkengarthdale School was the first school I attended, and so I was pleased to be able to go and of course it was certainly very different from when I first went there. The whole place was alive and I found the displays fascinating and the atmosphere electric, with the slight sadness associated with nostalgia. I feel we don't

always appreciate the role our schools play in - that is until they are our community threatened with closure, as has happened twice to Arkengarthdale School. It is now still open and flourishing thanks to the loyal and hardworking support of the community it serves. Well done to the school and here's to the nest 350 years! I could not resist printing the above picture of Mary Hall aged 96 who first started Arkengarthdale School in 1918 and only went to that School. She is pictured next to the commemorative plague unveiled by the Bishop (with a little help from some of the pupils) along with two of the youngest pupils, Oliver Allison age 4 and Emma Hodgson age 5.

as soon as this goes to print, the Summer will be over and we'll be back to rain and wind again! However, the. weather forecasters are

telling us that it's going to be a glorious summer. What a wonderful job that must be! I think I'll apply. Who will hold me accountable if I'm wrong? So to be a complete kill-joy, I'm going to tell you about the risks of being exposed to the sun. First, let me say that the sun is actually good for us. We need to store up vitamin D for the dark months ahead, to help improve our immunity to all the bad things that the winter brings, like colds and 'flu, and the best way to do that is to expose ourselves to sunlight so that the skin can absorb it. However, that doesn't mean we can expose our delicate white skin to the sun for hours and not expect it to turn bright pink and very sore. It is interesting that many people will take a sunscreen with them when they go on holiday. but for some reason believe that in the UK the sun is not as strong. Sunburn or sunstroke is no fun for anyone, and a sunscreen of at least factor 20 is recommended, applied every couple of hours. Babies and children are particularly susceptible to burning, so an even higher factor, liberally applied, is vital. The damage done to the skin by sunburn doesn't just have an immediate effect. It is cumulative, which means that the more times you get burned, the more likely it is you will store up trouble in the future. By far the most important item you need is a HAT especially if, to be politically correct, you are follicly challenged! #### Crime in the Two Dales





It seems the unfortunate man was a traveller who had been attacked and beaten to death, and unknown. then robbed. by someone Sometime later, after he had been buried, some children found a knife which had two initials burnt into the bone handle. Even after this lapse of time the villagers met for a meeting at the Punch Bowl, where someone claimed that he had seen the owner of the knife, a local poacher and drunkard, talking to the stranger at midnight on the night of the crime. There being no other suspect, the locals readily decided it was evidence that this man was the murderer. They hounded him down and shut him in a bam behind the local constabulary. However, he made his escape through the ling-thatched roof and ran to Old Gang, where he hid in the mines. But

he was found ,and the lynchers strung him up on a tree in Gallows Lane. Whether this incident gave the name to Gallows Top, or whether it was already a known site for such punishment, I don't know, but what is sure is that the folk made no concession to the law. Suspicion was enough, and the poor man paid by more than his reputation.


