Applicant must live in the Hambleton or Richmondshire Districts

Applicant must be aged 16+

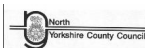
Require transport to enable them to travel to employment, training, education or job seeking.

The daily journey must be a practical distance for a moped



Successful candidates will receive a moped for six months after completing their Compulsory Basic Training (at no cost to the individual). Safety equipment will also be provided. Insurance, tax and servicing are covered. A contribution of £5.00 per week is required to cover general tyre

Please make the effort to be there as we look ahead together. The meeting will consist of the business meeting [which will cover the annual parish report] and a post meeting speaker. Once the business has concluded, the speaker for the evening is Mr Simon Eastwood. Simon is a manager at *The Jonas Centre* in Redmire, in Wensleydale. He will talk about the work of this local Christian centre, which offers holidays to families in need and works with a variety of church and other groups throughout the year. Refreshments will be served at this meeting so if you are able to come, please do put this date in your diary now and come to hear Simon speak about his work.

St Andrew's Bell Tower update

Please do keep supporting the events for the church tower fund. Our water supply now comes out of a tap connected to a sink [instead of a hosepipe with a tap attached] from within the environs of a very nice kitchen and the toilet is connected. Both these improvements to facilities were

appreciated at the double christening held within the 8th February service, particularly perhaps the application of warm rather than the more usual cold water for the Baptisms.

Coffee Morning : Thanks to all those who attended the Coffee Morning at the home of Margaret Abson on the morning of Saturday 17th January. The magnificent sum of £327.20 was raised for the bell tower appeal at this event. People literally packed into Margaret's cottage that morning and a very social event was had by all. And also to those who attended the Wine & Cheese Party at the Gallery - the home of Ralph and Joy Court. Held on a particularly cold January evening it produced a sum of £514 towards the bell tower appeal. Particular thanks are offered to the Wensleydale Creamery, whose sponsorship of the event provided cheeses of differing varieties for those present to try [and in more than one case, get hooked on!]. The Creamery to note to increase stock levels of Wensleydale with Ginger in particular - yummy perfect partner of retro menu favourite: cheese with pineapple chunks!

FAIRTRADE IN REETH

One thing that excited me about coming to Reeth was the fact that there was a Traidcraft stall once a month at the Friday morning Drop In at the Methodist Church. Now, with their full approval and support we are starting to sell it at The Old Temperance Bookshop. MESSAGE from the SWALEDALE
MUSEUM in REETH

Preparations for the 2009 Season are well underway, with lots of new things to see from Monday 6th April. We also have new opening times, we will be open daily except for Saturdays 10.30 to 5.30, which includes our refurbished café and shop. Our Friends Committee have raised funds for insulating the roof and thanks to a Heritage Grant from Richmond Council we have a new dataprojector. An audiopost will be available to hear the edited results of the Swaledale Voices oral history project, with great thanks to all those who have been involved in this exciting venture, both recorders and those who have been recorded! Over the winter we rescued two handsome cabinets from the Bowes Museum Library, which now house new displays on the old shops of Reeth and the Dale. We also have a new archive bay. Thanks to Graham from Scenic View Gallery we have a brand new beautifully designed website which will include our online archive database (see www.swaledalemuseum.org). We have a whole series of events throughout the year including a 'Looking after your Family Heirlooms' afternoon on Saturday 6th June, embroidery demonstrations in conjunction with the Richmond and Leyburn Embroiderers Guild 10th anniversary exhibition over the Swaledale Festival, and a new series of summer evening events called 'Conversations in Craft' with leading

January 2009

Highway Matters Problems would be again relayed to the Highways Department. These included potholes in Hurst and Marske, water on the roads, overhanging vegetation and deteriorating road edges. All members were alarmed by the serious subsidence of the road near Downholme Bridge and Councillor Stones expressed fears that any further deterioration could cause a grave accident. Councillor Hodgson remarked on the difficulties experienced by the school buses. Some repair work had been done in the past, but it was thought a more thorough solution was required. Winter maintenance was discussed at some length. Councillor Wilhelmy reported on the patchy gritting. The Chair commented that local knowledge was essential. Councillor Blackie stated that payment to farmers was insufficient, particularly when considering the cost of insurance required. Councillor Richardson remarked on difficulties in contacting the relevant individual to report problems. Councillor Hodgson felt complaints produced little result, though the Clerk's urgent request for more gritheaps had received immediate attention. Councillor Blackie passed on apologies from the Highways Department for their lack of preparedness. The Area Manager, Mr Woodford, would be asked to accompany Councillor Blackie to the next meeting of the Parish Council to respond to concerns. Community Safety On 10 December 2008 the Clerk accompanied Police Constable Kirvell, Police Community Support Officer Taylor-Page and Kate Davies from Richmondshire Community Safety Partnership on a walkabout in

Marrick to point out any problem areas or issues relevant to the Safer Neighbourhoods initiative. The Clerk also attended a Watch group meeting at Leeming on 12 January, where the Chief Constable had stressed the importance of partnership working. Councillor Blackie reported on the increase in thefts from farms in the Dales and of the dissatisfaction with police response times, which he would raise at the Area Committee meeting on 21 January. Parish Land The Chair reported wall repairs were required at Low Buska. Freedom of Information Publication Scheme The new model publication scheme for all public authorities came into effect on 1 January. It replaced all previously approved schemes, which had now expired. The new scheme aimed to encourage greater openness and transparency across the public sector. All local councils should have two documents in place, a completed guide to information and a copy of the model scheme. Following a proposal by Councillor Stones, seconded by Councillor Hodgson, it was resolved to adopt the model scheme without modification. Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority call for housing sites Following consultation on future housing policies in the National Park, the YDNP were seeking to identify a suitable range of sites for affordable and local needs housing, where this would support the economic and social well being of local communities. The Government stated there was a requirement to build 88 homes each year for the next 5 years. However Councillor Blackie informed the meeting that YDNPA wanted 44. £5000 per plot had been set by Government to be paid to

the landowner. Councillors were of the opinion that Marrick would not be deemed suitable. Precept After examining the Council's planned budget for the forthcoming year, and bearing in mind the present economic climate, Councillors resolved there would be no increase. It was proposed by Councillor Hodgson, seconded by Councillor Wilhelmy, that a precept of £ 1200 be issued, for the third consecutive year. Correspondence The Final Report of the Transport and Telecommunication Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee on the review on winter maintenance, had been received, the first major review since 1974. Following concerns by an Independent Planning Inspector, appointed by the Secretary of State, work on North Yorkshire Minerals and Waste Development Framework Minerals and Waste Core Strategies was being reviewed. Any representations or objections to the modification order to delete part of Bridleway no 28 south of Marrick Priory through the building and Church graveyard for approximately 85 metres, should be sent to YDNPA by 13 February. Free training courses were to be arranged for volunteers to become 'waste warriors', to spread the word about waste minimisation to local communities.

Any Other Business Councillor Blackie hoped to arrange for the mobile skip service to visit Marrick later in the year. It would be at Reeth on 21 March. The Chair thanked Councillor Blackie for

attending the meeting.

Date of next meeting 19 March 2009, following the Annual Parish Meeting at 7.00 p.m. at Marrick Institute.

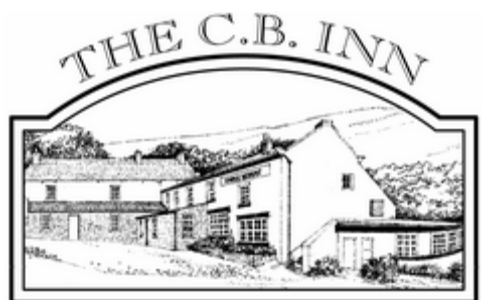

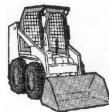

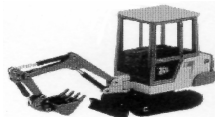

No doubt many of you will have been keeping fit shovelling snow from your paths and driveways. Great exercise, but do watch those backs!

Shovelling, digging, gardening - all good for keeping fit and active, which leads me nicely on to the NHS Change 4 Life campaign you might have seen on television. At the surgery we have all sorts of information to help you and our younger patients embrace a healthier lifestyle. An increasing number of children are being diagnosed with diabetes and obesity - not a good start to life. Please ask our Receptionists for a booklet called 'Top tips for top kids' - good advice for all kids from 1 to 101! It's been said before but 5 portions of fruit or vegetables a day really do make a difference to a healthier lifestyle, and may reduce the risk of heart disease, strokes and some cancers. Some of us are often confused, however, as to what constitutes a portion, or how easy it is to achieve your 5 a day. For example, a glass of orange juice makes up 1 portion. Butter beans or half a small tin of baked beans can be another portion, so even if you hate broccoli and sprouts, there are lots of alternatives. A good guide is to '*eat a rainbow*' - in other words, eat as many different colours of fruit and vegetables as you can. Pick up a booklet next time you're passing the surgery.

I mentioned last month that after April people who have cancer and are paying prescription charges for cancer drugs will be exempt from payment. You need to collect a new FP92A form from us. Ask

our Dispensers, Amanda or Christine, who will be pleased to help you. Lots of news this month and we're pleased to announce that another service is being made available at Reeth Medical Centre for our community. In addition to the current services including physiotherapy, chiropody and acupuncture, Janet Mason, a Mental Health Practitioner will be available at Reeth on alternate Fridays. Appointments with Janet need to be referred by either Dr Anderson or myself, so please feel free to talk to us. That's all this month. Get out, get active and enjoy the Spring weather - whatever its like! All the best.
