Last month we saw incidents relating to the theft of guad bikes in the Dales. Enquiries

are on going, Police operations are in progress, and there have been arrests. We have also received reports of incidents relating to either damage to vehicles or theft of items from inside vehicles. In the area of Wathaill camp a 'Tom Tom' was removed from a vehicle damaged in a road accident, a handbag was taken from a car in Reeth where a window had been left open, a pair of binoculars were taken from a van in Arkengarthdale and a Whacker plate was removed from the back of an open vehicle in Fremington. An attempt was made to break into a vehicle at Arkenaarthdale and a window was smashed on another vehicle in Langthwaite. It goes without saving that we strongly advise you that vehicles must be locked and made secure at all times and that any items of value are either stored out of sight or removed from the vehicle if at all possible. Theft of money was reported from a church collection box at St. Andrews in Grinton. There were several reports of suspicious vehicles and persons around the Dales, all of which after further checks proved to be in order. A member of the public contacted by Capquest was Collection Company behalf on Vodaphone. Remember to check all mail carefully and be mindful not to disclose any personal details. Yorkshire Pudding recipe from Mrs. Beeton's Everyday Cookery Book (1923)

Ingredients: 1 pint of milk, 2 eggs, 4 heaped tablespoons of flour, a little fine salt and some good dripping.

Method: Put flour and a good pinch of salt into a basin, make a well in the centre, break in the eggs, stir gradually, mixing in the flour from the sides, and add milk by degrees until a thick, smooth batter is formed. Now beat well for 10 minutes, then add the remainder of the milk, cover and let it stand for at least an hour. When ready to use, cover the bottom of a pudding tin with a thin layer of dripping taken from the meat tin, and while the tin and dripping are getting thoroughly hot in the oven, give the batter another good beating. Bake the pudding for about 10 minutes in a hot oven partially to cook the bottom, or if more convenient, place the hottest shelf from the oven on the meat stand, and at once put the pudding in front of the fire and cook it until set and well browned. "Yorkshire" pudding is always cooked in front of the fire, when baked in the oven, the term "batter pudding" is applied to it by the people in the county whence it derives its name. This pudding is frequently served with gravy and as a rule, before the meat

Two Dales Live! The waiting is over. We are pleased to announce our new arrival: 'Two Dales Live!' - a secure, internet based service.

which allows patients face to face access to their doctor from an external location. as well as to a wide range of medical services. We believe Two Dales Live will be of areatest benefit to those who live and work in remote locations or who find it difficult to come in to the medical centre. It won't, of course, replace a face to face consultation should you wish to see the doctor in person, although through the wonders of the 'web-cam', both doctor and patient can see each other throughout the consultation. Suitable consultations include advice, medication reviews or the sending of information to/from the doctor. This is probably the first scheme in the country where patients can access their GP via the internet, and an exciting step forward in patient care. There is already a lot of interest from the wider NHS - so you can see that the two Dales are really leading the wav! How can I access this service? At the moment Two Dales Live can only be accessed from the booths in the village halls or from Hudson House in Reeth. (It will not work from a home computer), and it is currently a pilot project, as we try to assess what the demand will be. We are asking patients to pre-book a consultation as they would normally arrange a face to face consultation.

Prepayment Certificates for Prescriptions I'm sure many of you will be aware that you are entitled to free prescriptions or even

with the cost prescriptions, but some of you may not. If you are over 60 you already qualify for free prescriptions and many others are exempt from payment for a variety of reasons, but a large percentage of people are not, and this is where it becomes expensive for people who require a lot of medication In the current economic climate many of us are having to tighten our belts, so it is worth being aware that it may be better to buy a Prescription Prepayment Certificate or PPC as it is known. A PPC is worth while if:

you need more than 4 prescription items in 3 months
you need more than 14 prescription items in 12 months

On 1st April 2009 the cost of a single prescription item increased to £7.20. A 3 month PPC will cost you £28.25 and a 12 month PPC will cost £104. So you can see there is a saving if you need quite a few medications. Once you have a PPC, there is no extra charge if you need other medication, for example, courses antibiotics or pain-killers for unexpected problems. Marrick Parish Council

Chairman. Councillor Barrie The Braithwaite, presented his Annual Report of business conducted by the Parish Council, for the financial year 2008-09, at the Annual Parish Meeting held on 19 March 2009. County Councillor Blackie and Mike Woodford, Highways Area Manager, attended the Parish Council meeting which followed. Mr Woodford gave an insight into the work of his department, who relied on being informed if there was a problem. Members reported on the difficulties in communication via the call centre. Councillor Blackie stressed the importance of winter maintenance throughout the Dales. The Chair considered the level of service was unsatisfactory. Mr Woodford stated that of salt had caused problems throughout the country.

reply to Councillor Richardson's suggestion that grit could be stockpiled in a good winter to use when conditions were more severe. Mr Woodford said this was not possible. There was insufficient available and the storaae maintenance allocation had never been sufficient. Mr Woodford explained that policy dictated what could be done. There were 8 gritters. The Chair considered machines were needed Woodford explained that because of the severe weather this winter, time was spent on priority 1 and 2 roads. The number of priority route 3s in North Yorkshire was vast and some were never treated. Councillor Stones felt gritting should be concentrated on hills. Mr Woodford said that when aritters attended they treated all the route. Following further lengthy Councillor Blackie felt there was a need to examine the possibility of making a route into Marrick priority 2 to enable earlier treatment. The Chair stressed Hurst also needed consideration. Other

highways problems which had previously been reported were then conveyed to Mr Woodford. He confirmed these were to be attended to, the subsidence near Downholme Bridge in the very near future. Planning Matters There were no objections to the application for change of use from former Methodist Chapel to a single house, and for listed building consent for structural alterations including new ceilings, windows and new openings at Chapel House, Hurst.

<u>Tenders for Parish Land</u> Tenders were accepted for High Buska - Bainbridge Bros, Low Buska - N White, Nungate Top - A Bainbridge.

Councillor Blackie reported on the recent theft of a quad bike. This had been subsequently found, but there had been some concern with police liaison. It was agreed there were no projects in the locality which could involve the Community Payback scheme, where offenders carried out unpaid work under the supervision of the National Probation Assessments were to be carried out on properties where residents were required to leave their refuse and recycling containers at lane-ends for collection. This could result in a return to previous collection points where practicable.




