

CLIMATE CHANGE GAME

A new online game has been launched that aims to increase awareness of the effects of climate change in the Yorkshire Dales National Park. Players have to run a Snakes and Ladders-type gauntlet as they travel round the board, climbing up some of National Park's famous limestone pavements or sliding downing waterfalls answering climate change-related questions if they land on certain squares. The game was the brainchild of Meghann Hull the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority's acting Interpretation Officer, and the Authority's Web Officer Stuart Willis. Meghann said: "Climate change is a serious issue for the National Park and we wanted to create a fun way of making people aware that they can all help to minimise its impact when they visit. "The game is aimed primarily at young people but mums and dads can have a go too - in fact, they may be surprised at some of the answers." The game, located online at www.yorkshiredales.org.uk/ climatechangegame, was devised with the help of Leeds-based Sense Internet. Stuart said: "A key target for the game is teachers. We worked closely with Sense to enable the game to be a valuable teaching resource and help raise awareness amona teachers of the broader educational resources supplied by the YDNPA. This in turn should increase interest in relevant Authority as a source educational material and increase school and family visits to the Dales." The YDNPA aims to achieve 'carbon neutral' status by 2012.

REETH BONFIRE 2009

Open public bonfires are coming under

increasina regulations. mainly insurance companies. year Last Fireworks Committee tried to have a bonfire made entirely of pallets so that its size could be regulated and it could be put out by the Fire Brigade at the end of the night. We simply failed as the fire did not burn as quickly as we had hoped and had to be left to die naturally. This year after much discussion with the Parish Council, there will be an open bonfire again but with the following restrictions: 1. No material is to be left on the Green until 1st November and the site will be closed when it is considered large enough. 2. An RDC skip will be on the Green on 31st October for any unsuitable material, 3. The bonfire HAS to be 25m away from the general public i.e. in the position it was in last year. 4. A list of 'Yes please' and 'No Thank you' items will be displayed around the site.

This committee and the Parish Council are trying desperately to maintain a tradition in Reeth which goes back generations. Your help and forbearance would be greatly appreciated. We hope that you will understand and embrace the new slogan 'Abuse it and you will lose it'

ANNUAL 'FLU **VACCINATION** Seasonal 'Flu

Following on from last month's article. this vear's 'Flu Vaccination

Clinic will be held on Friday 9th October at the Medical Centre from 11am to 3pm. You don't need to make an appointment. Just come to the Reception and Janice or Vicki will book you in. The seasonal 'flu vaccine is offered to all our patients over the age of 65 as well as people who suffer from the following conditions:

Chronic Respiratory Disease (COPD. asthma, etc)

Chronic Heart Disease (e.g. heart failure)

Chronic Kidney Disease

Chronic Liver Disease

Chronic Neurological Disease (e.g.

Parkinson's Disease)

Diabetes

Immunosuppression (suppressed immune system due to disease or drugs)

Patients who suffer from these conditions come under what the NHS calls the 'at risk' category. It is very important that these people receive the vaccine because are more likely to develop complications from 'flu such as pneumonia requiring hospital treatment. We realise of course that some of you housebound. If this is the case and you would like a 'flu vaccination, just contact our Reception and we'll arrange for you to have this at home.

Swine 'Flu As you are no doubt aware, the Government has ordered supplies of the Swine 'Flu vaccine ready for this winter. This vaccine will be ready by October, so we hope to offer it to patients at the All the best - Mike Brookes and the Team

same time as the seasonal 'flu vaccine as many of our patients will be eligible for both. The Department of Health has not given us a date for delivery of the swine 'flu vaccine, so please bear with us!

QUESTIONS AND MYTHS:

If I am vaccinated for 'flu, won't I catch it from the vaccine? No. vaccine does not contain live virus, so it is impossible to catch 'flu from receiving your jab - this applies to both Seasonal and Swine 'flu vaccines. Am I eligible for the Swine 'flu vaccine? The NHS will make the Swine 'flu vaccine available to those people with the same conditions mentioned above, as these people are considered to However, if you are over be most at risk. 65 but do not suffer from a chronic disease, you do not need the Swine 'flu vaccination. Therefore, you are not eligible for it. Pregnant women may be offered the Swine 'flu vaccination but this has not yet been confirmed by the Department of Health.

To make all this miserable stuff about 'flu more bearable, we've decided that on the day of the 'Flu Clinic we're going to have a charity coffee morning. We hope it will become an annual event and we intend to support a different charity each year. This year we have chosen Macmillan Cancer Care. You don't have to be coming for your 'flu vaccination, you can just join in the fun. So come along, have your jab and get stuck into the coffee and cakes. There might even be a tombola. Dear Sir, Between Friday the 14th August 2009 and Friday 21st August we had a holiday in the beautiful village of Healaugh, staying at Sunny Brae East.

Unfortunately on the Wednesday of that week our two year old black Labrador, Sam. r was knocked down by a car, sustaining a broken right leg, cuts and bruises and a collapsed lung. Thankfully he has survived the accident and is now on the mend".

The reason I bring this to you're attention is the fat the accident happened in the village and the help kindness and support given by some of the people in the village was to say in the least exceptional. People were so considerate and offered help in anyway they could and the Pybus family were just out of this world.

Ian Pybus initially took Sam to the vets in Richmond with my wife in his van while I followed in my car. The following day, Thursday, he actually drove us all the way to Cramlington, near Newcastle. Where we had Sam cooked in for an operation later that day. This was after my car failed to start and a tyre on it burst! We were completely stuck, but Ian drove us to Richmond when we collected sam, then drove us all the way to Cramlington where we delivered Sam to the Vetinary Surgeon who was waiting for us. Then drove us all the way back to Healaugh.

This kind of help and kindness was just unbelievable and although the accident caused myself, my wife and of course Sam a great deal of distress and trauma, the response form the people in the village just restored our faith in humanity and everyone I have spoken to and told of the

accident feel exactly the same way.

We just wanted to somehow say thank you to all the people in the village of Healaugh and we will certainly come back in the near future for hopefully a somewhat better holiday.

So thank you Healaugh and a special thanks to Ian Pybus and his family.





A Grandson 's Return to Yorkshire.

New Zealand Artist Colin Kendall looks
forward to creating a series of portraits

forward to creating a series of portraits of some of his Yorkshire relatives"

never knew my grandfather from Yorkshire, but I did meet him once. When I was a small boy my father took me to the nearby town of Feilding to my grandfather's house. We went into the old man's room so he and I could meet. Grandfather was in bed, He remained asleep, snoring loudly, He and my father had been estranged since 1912, when my father left home at fourteen. hating the office job his step-mother had placed him in and determined upon the life of a back-country stockman, Grandfather died the week following our visit, I have a vague memory of standing on a windy hillside on the upland side of New Zealand's Manawatu Plains in the Feilding cemetery, surrounded by family and clutching my mother's gloved hand, listening to the Anglican Church's Order for Burial. The headstones of immigrant relatives who had made the journey from Yorkshire were close by. During the nineteenth century the English lead mining industry collapsed, forcing the mines and smelters in Yorkshire to close. Grandfather, his brothers, his only sister and her husband and other relatives from the district surrounding the villages of Reeth and Grinton, a centre of lead production, emigrated to New Zealcnd, to Australia, Canada and the USA as a practical alternative to starvation. Grandfather, following the others in his family, walked to Grimsby and eventually found work there to finance his passage. He intended to join his brothers and sister in New Zealand, but in Hobart, while the ship was being provisioned for the three-thousand mile crossing of the Tasman Sea between Tasmania and New Zealand, Grandfather met a young lady whose parents had emigrated from the Isle of Man two decades earlier. Grandfather and Isobel Cannell married, and instead of going on to New Zealand, took a farm selection in the bush near Sydney, at Grahamstown, a gold-mining settlement in the Blue Mountains, where they endured nine years of withering drought. After bringing four children into the world, my grandmother died shortly after the birth of their second daughter. Grandfather's only option then was to leave Australia with his four small children and go to his sister Lizzie and her husband George, now settled and prosperous farmers in the Manawatu district of the North Island of New Zealand, Grandfather and his four children settled to life in New Zealand. He eventually married again and his new wife produced one son, but Grandfather's relationship with his elder four children atrophied rapidly after his second marriage. Although my father was immensely proud of being an Australian and a New South Welshman, he cheerfully signed up and fought for his adopted country through the first and the second world wars. He initially served in Flanders as a Mounted Trooper in the Taranaki Mounted Rifles and in I taly and the Middle East as a machine gunner in 27 MG Battalion. He was intensely proud of being British and part of the greatest Empire the world had seen. After WWII he would become grumpy during discussions about the breaking-up of the old Empire by what he saw foolish English politicians maintained, had no idea of the economic power of the empire they had tossed to the winds. Very early in WWII, my brother George joined the RNZAF at sixteen and went from boarding school to Woodburne in the South Island, an Air Force establishment for pilot training. Immediately he earned his wings he was shipped to England as a Pilot Officer, flew a Mosquito fighter/bomber for a huge number of sorties over Germany and the Low Countries

before destroying 'his' Mosquito and losing his from Scalby, near Scarborough on the other life in a flying accident just before his squadron was to fly out to India. He is buried in the Commonwealth War Graves section of the Cambridge city cemetery. Eventually, my wife and I had the opportunity to travel to the UK to attend our younger daughter's marriage to a young man from Surrey. After a few years living and working here, our mindset has changed: we are no longer tourists, are still very definitely Kiwis, but feel a tremendous sense of belonging in the United Kingdom. The arrival of grandchildren since we landed in the UK, both here and in New Zealand, has complicated our situation. Our current solution is to holiday in New Zealand as frequently as possible. I have always been aware of my family's roots in Yorkshire. One of my treasured possessions is the leather-bound Bible given to my great grandfather in 1844 when he was aged nine for reciting the Catechism, some prayers and seven of the psalms, which he and his peers were required to memorise. The Bibles, a gift from the estate of Phillip, the late Lord Wharton, are now presented each year to new communicants in parishes across the UK. The genealogy of my Kendall line is kept among the fly leaves of this Bible, which seems fitting as many of my forebears are buried in the churchyard at Grinton, where my copy was presented by the Vicar of Grinton. My wife and I enjoyed a brief tour of North Yorkshire not long after we arrived in the UK, as guests of relatives James and Jennifer Kendall of Reeth. James is the grandson of my Grandfather's brother and has always lived in Reeth. grandfather didn't settle in New Zealand after emigrating there, but returned to Reeth at about the time my own grandfather was heading to New Zealand with his young children. In the first decade of the 20th century, my wife's father emigrated with his parents and older brother to New Zealand

side of Yorkshire, but I guess that's another story. I now feel as if I am being drawn toward a homecoming of sorts in Yorkshire and the series of portraits I am about to embark on will mark that homecoming in a unique way. I have drawn and painted all my life and was fortunate to be invited to train as a Fine Arts specialist teacher in my late thirties, which eventually enabled me to have parallel careers as an artist and teacher for the next couple of decades until I retired from teaching and could devote my time to painting. I am a studio artist, a practice born of my experience in New Zealand. which has high average wind speeds and a teeming insect life = there is no pleasure in wrestling with a windblown canvas and easel while plucking insects from fresh paint, so I draw and take photographs as field studies on which to base my finished paintings. I carry out considerable research to gain a thorough understanding of each subject and do extensive mental planning so have a very dear idea of how each painting should look before I begin. I work in watercolour. oils or acrylics with equal pleasure. I am happy to paint any subject and enjoy the various challenges. I am particularly enthusiastic creating portraits of other enthusiasts doing whatever they are enthusiastic about. My range of portrait subjects is extensive and those of 'The late Humphrey Lyttelton' and 'The Lambourn Farrier' are two of many.




