A selection of art by local artists will be auctioned by Rodney Tennant at the charity auction at Tennants in Leyburn on Thursday, September 17. And there will be some very entertaining music thanks to Rick Dickerlous and the Outrage supported by Lil and the Lillettes! The proceeds from the auction will go to the UK charity, Friends of Govi, which helps blind and visually impaired children in the Gambia. A magnificent collage by Janet Rawlins will be auctioned and the other artists who have donated pictures include Judith Bromley, Piers Browne, Winifred Hodge, Roger Lofts, Moira Metcalfe, Nancy Murgatroyd and Jo Stockdale. All the art will be on show at Tennants from September 2, with much it already on view at www.friendsofgovi.org.uk.

The evening will start with canapes and wine at 5pm and the gig with Rick Dickerlous (aka Rod Baxter of Leyburn) and his friends will begin at 5.30pm. This will not only include Rod's own composition *Sweet Jane* which won such acclaim at this year's Wensleydale Tournament of Song but also some items he has written especially for this gig such as: *Ode to Northern Women* and *Dr Gazebo's Time Travelling Medicine Show*.

Those attending the auction will also have the opportunity to take part in a grand raffle with some excellent prizes.

The Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority has a new chairman.

Members voted to elect Craven District Councillor Carl Lis. He stood down last year after completing four years as chairman and was replaced by South Lakeland

District Councillor Kevin Lancaster.

Mr Lis highlighted the importance of the National Park Authority in playing a fuller and more active role in Yorkshire and Cumbria regions as the new political arrangements are developed.

Local farmer Harold Brown from Grinton in Swaledale, was re-elected as deputy chairman. The National Park Authority has a new main telephone number. The number to ring for general enquiries is 0300 456 0030. The Authority's old 0870 1 666333 telephone number - which has run alongside the 0300 number for several months to ease the change over - no longer exists. The numbers for the Bainbridge and Grassington offices and other sites, such as the Dales Countryside Museum, plus all other direct dial numbers will remain the same.

Arkengarthdale Parish Council has recently been successful in obtaining grants from North Yorkshire County Council Community Fund and Richmondshire District Council Heritage Fund to repair the Retaining Wall beside the Arkle beck adjacent to St. Mary's Church Graveyard. Clark Stones, Chairman of the Parish Council, made a presentation in Richmond which resulted in grants of over £7,000. The Community of Arkengarthdale is very grateful for the support received from both Authorities for this essential work.

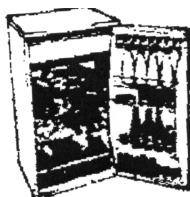

Crime in the Two Dales

Last month we had a report of an attempted theft of scrap metal and a metal gate from the area of Marske. Two males were reported for asking for Red diesel from a local farm .A vehicle that appeared to be abandoned in High Fremington had in fact had it's number plates removed. Two males were trying to sell Pressure washers in the area of Brokes. A quad bike was stolen in Gunnerside from an insecure garage and the lock was attacked in order to remove the bike. Attempts were made to brake into a garage in Muker where the padlock was sawn off and the metal bar was bent but the offender(s) failed to gain entry. In order to return items that have been stolen , recording of the identification number / serial numbers placed on them, would establish whether or not the item was indeed stolen and who it belonged to. So when new goods are purchased can I remind you to record the items numbers/ code. Overnight 31st July- 1st August two "guests" took a room at The Kings Arms where the bill was left unpaid and a television, kettle, bedding and towels were removed from the room. The couple, a male and female were aged about 40ish both around 5'4" and slim build. The male was bald and the female had spiky black hair. FLU VACCINATION As if it isn't enough to be bombarded with information about Swine 'Flu, hot on its tail is that other Winter nasty, the

normal seasonal 'FLU that sadly will be heading our way soon. So it looks like we're going to have to fight a battle on two fronts! Without wishing to be a soothsayer of doom and gloom ('Woe, Woe and thrice Woe!' - Janice will have me join the Reeth Artyfacts yet), it is important to let you know that if you are in any of the 'at risk' groups you qualify for vaccination free of charge (at least that's some good news!). People at risk are those who suffer from chronic respiratory diseases including asthma, as well as other chronic diseases such as kidney illness, diabetes, heart and liver disorders. If you are a carer for an elderly or disabled person you may be at greater risk of contracting 'flu, so you would also benefit from the 'flu jab. Others who qualify are those who are aged **above 65 years**, or who may have reduced immunity, for example, those undergoing chemotherapy, or who suffer with a virus that affects the immune system. If you are not sure if you fall into any of these categories, please give Janice or Vicki a call and they will advise you. It is important to protect yourself even if you had a 'flu jab in previous years, because the strains of the 'flu virus keep changing, so the vaccines have to improve to cope with these changes, thus giving you increased protection. We intend to hold a 'Flu Vaccination Clinic in the **Autumn** so you can be sure you receive your jab in good time to protect you through the Winter months. The time and date of the clinic will be announced soon, so 'watch this space' in the next Gazette article and we'll also post details at the surgery. In the

meantime, give your immunity a boost by getting lots of vitamin C and D into your system. Vitamin C can be found in fruit and vegetables, and vitamin D in oily fish such as salmon, tuna, mackerel and sardines, as well as eggs. Sunshine is also a great provider of vitamin D. That's why people in the sunnier countries get fewer occurrences of seasonal 'flu. So make the most of the sun when it shines, but, of course, treat it with respect and never expose babies to unprotected sunlight. **WOMEN'S HEALTH CLINICS** You may recall that Kim, our Nurse, has a special interest in women's health and sexual health matters. We are now pleased to offer a regular clinic run by Kim every Monday from now on between 3.00 pm to 4.00 pm. So if this time is convenient for you, just ask our Receptionists to book you a slot. Of course, this does not exclude you from seeing Kim at any other time, but this clinic will be specifically reserved for patients wishing to discuss these subjects with her. She can also carry out smear tests during this clinic.

KEEPING YOUR APPOINTMENT In recent weeks we have been experiencing a number of appointment slots where people failed to attend. This has in the past been a rarity, and most patients realise that it has slipped their minds and are very apologetic. Janice or Vicki will usually give you an appointment card, but if in doubt, don't hesitate to give us a call or drop in just to confirm your next appointment. Don't worry, you won't be told off, but obviously, if an appointment is made and then people don't turn up, it may affect someone who has been put off because the slots are full and may need to see us urgently. What I'm saying is, please try to remember your appointment and keep to your allotted time. That's all this month.

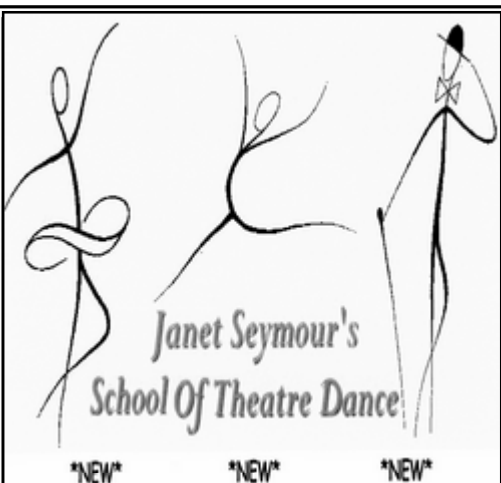

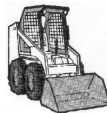

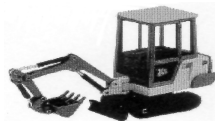

DALE'S WATERWHEELS

Waterwheels could be turning again all over the Yorkshire Dales National Park if a

scheme to generate electricity is backed by landowners and residents. Nearly 50 potential sites for small-scale hydro-electric units have been considered in a study commissioned by the YDNPA. Authority members have agreed to spend up to £3,000 to arrange seminars to promote small-scale hydro power to National Park landowners and communities groups. The Authority's Sustainable Development Officer, said: "The Dales has a long history of harnessing waterpower for its traditional industries and many of its villages had their own electricity schemes in the early 1900s. Today, with increasing energy costs, Government incentives and concerns about carbon dioxide emissions, there is growing local interest to examine the hydro potential of former mill sites and to investigate new ones." "The YDNPA is keen to see the development of small-scale hydro-power sites to meet local energy needs - and the restoration of former sites also offers an opportunity to conserve some of our most important local buildings. For example, we have already helped to get hydro power schemes off the ground at Gayle Mill and Yore Mill at Aysgarth and have supported the design of schemes at Linton Falls and Farfield Mill". The Authority intends to host one or two seminars about small-scale hydro power in the Dales later this year. Visit: www.yorkshiredales.org.uk/hydro-power_feasibility
