

TAKING OVER YOUR LIFE? Many of you are receiving prescriptions α reaular basis. Repeat prescriptions are

carefully monitored by the doctors, and occasionally you are asked to come in and see us to review them. From time to time. yourself find with medication than you need. Either because the doctors have. changed prescription, you may have ordered more than you thought, or because they've simply got out of sync. We've all got a drawer at home filled with everything from paperclips to garden seeds so it may be no surprise to find an old packet of Diclofenac that's 3 years out of date! In truth, we all get in a muddle, and at RMC we offer a free disposal service for out of date or unwanted medicines. Many people are surprised to learn that, even if they're in date, we can't re-use or re-issue them. The government is insisting the NHS tightens up on all this, and to some extent it's about time we all played our part in reducing the massive wastage in unwanted or unused medicines which cost the NHS a staggering £800 million a year. dispensing budget is constantly being monitored and reduced, so we are also trying to find the most competitive ways to ensure our patients receive their vital medication. So, a big 'PLEASE' from us Help us and others by carefully checking if you absolutely need the medication you order. If in doubt, ask either Christine or Amanda to check when you were last issued with certain items particularly if it is something you don't get cotton buds thwarts this mechanism

ARE YOUR MEDICINES every time you order a prescription. DOSETTE BOXES Quite a number of our patients use a very effective way of managing their medicines - by using a dosette box. These are transparent flat boxes with small pockets into which the Dispensers place the right medication for each day of the week - separating dosage into morning, mid-day, evening and night time if required.

The advantages of a dosette box are:

You don't have to order them every month - they will be done automatically and checked for any adjustments by the doctor

You don't have to open several packets of pills (a fiddly job at the best of times)

Once you've taken them you know they're gone - no worries like "Now did I remember to take my water tablet?"

They reduce waste - even the boxes can be recycled

If you would like to try a dosette box, just let Christine or Amanda know. Nothing is set in stone - if you don't like them you can just revert to your usual method of ordering. LOOKING AFTER YOUR EARS Kim, our Nurse receives requests from time to time for ear-syringing, so I wanted to make you aware of a few facts to do with the ears, and help you to look after yours. Ear Nose and Throat (ENT) specialists have discovered that the wax produced by the skin of the ears has properties antibacterial and infection. The ears are designed to self clean by the skin growing in an outward direction bringing the wax with it. Using causing the wax to block the ears. Some people such as the elderly, those with particularly hairy ears, or wear hearing aids can get a build up of wax which can lead to a number of symptoms, most notably hearing loss. There are a couple of methods for dealing with ear wax. Self Help Drops can be bought or prescribed to soften wax and promote the natural the clearing of wax from ears. Alternatively, olive oil sodium or bicarbonate ear drops can be used for 14-28 days. This method may entirely avoid the need for syringing, or soften the wax to prepare the ears for the procedure. Ear Syringing This should be carried out only after consultation with the Doctors or Kim to check whether it is safe and/or appropriate, as in some cases this procedure can carry risks like perforation of the ear drum, infection and damage to the ear canal. At RMC our policy is to promote the use of ear drops to cut down the risk of complications, and ensure that ear syringing is deemed medically essential before we attempt it, so you may be asked by our Receptionists to book in for an initial appointment with Kim to assess this. 

### DID ANY OF YOUR ANCESTORS SERVE AT GALLIPOLI DURING THE GREAT WAR?

Are you interested in the events that took place? Have you ever thought about visiting the battlefields?

Chris Best spent 37 years in the Army. He joined as a boy soldier and followed a career path through Central American, Far Eastern and African jungles, Middle Eastern Deserts and the Arctic to the Ministry of Defence, international headquarters and beyond. For much of his Service life he was responsible for training of officers and senior soldiers.

Since retiring he has spent much time guiding military groups around the sites of great battles and campaigns in order to enhance soldiers' professional development. Each year Chris organizes trips for non-military parties who want to know what their forebears did in war: why they fought; and how they were recruited, equipped and trained. This September he's going to Turkey for a week. Gallipoli is one of the most evocative battlefields of the Great War. The events there shaped nations and its echoes are evident in current military doctrine. Gallipoli is also stunningly beautiful. We'll have the battlefields to ourselves for much of the time. The ground, in places, offers tough sometimes steep going, and is precipitous. We're unlikely to walk more than 5 miles in one go - but you'll know you've been

walking! A vehicle-borne itinerary will be set up for those who wouldn't want to do the longer walks.

The target price, dependent on numbers, will be at least £200 less than the cheapest commercial firm. If you are

#### Marrick Parish Council

The Chair presented the Annual Report of Business conducted by the Parish Council at the Annual Parish Meeting held on 11 March 2010. This was followed by the Parish Council Meeting, when once again concerns were raised regarding inadequate winter maintenance. The Chair had inspected the

parish land and reported there were no serious problems, though some wall repairs were required. Tenders were accepted for High Buska Bainbridge Bros, Low Buska - N White, and Nungate Top - A Bainbridge. Planning permission had been granted for the retention of the caravan used for staff accommodation at Marrick Priory. caravan was to be removed by 1 December on occupation of any accommodation building, whichever was the sooner. YDNPA had replied to the Parish Council's response to the management of the Fremington - Hurst 'green lane'. It was recommended to continue to monitor the route, consider signage, and price up repairs. Councillors studied maps and related documents on proposals to extend the Lake District and Yorkshire Dales National Parks. It was gareed that a response would be submitted that in the event of boundaries extended. membership beina of Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority should be increased to maintain the current level and allocation of local authority and parish council representation and adequately reflect the political representation of the new areas designated. A practical guide to duty of regard for authorities whose activities affected Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty and National Parks was studied and noted by all present. The proposal to develop a Parish Charter, which would set out the respective roles and obligations of principal authorities and parish councils, was discussed by Members. Whilst welcoming involvement in the decision-making process, Councillors had some reservations with the draft document. Date of next meeting 13 May 2010 at Marrick Institute.





### BRASS BANDS IN THE SWALEDALE FESTIVAL

The hills of Swaledale will resonate with the sound of one of Britain's most famous, prizewinning brass bands, when the Carlton Main Frickley Colliery Band leaves the former coalfields of West Yorkshire to appear at the Swaledale Festival. of the most in one magnificent landscapes οf the Yorkshire Dales. Formed in 1884, the Carlton Main Frickley Colliery Band is a typical British brass band, from the former mining village of South Elmsall. During its long and successful history it has triumphed at many of the most prestigious competitions in the world, holding its own against the very best and most prestigious bands including Grimethorpe Colliery, Black Dyke, and Brighouse and Rastrick to name a few. At the recent area competition in Bradford, Carlton Main came second knocking Black Dyke and Grimethorpe into fourth and fifth places. During the past two years the band has steadily worked its way into the top 10 in the World Rankings through consistent performances in major contests. Its success is due in no little part to the presence of world-class musicians in its ranks, including multi-award winning Principal Cornet player Kirsty Abbotts, and current professional Musical Director Phillip McCann The Band appears at the Swaledale Festival on Saturday 5th June at St. Andrew's Church, Grinton, Local bands of a similar age are also well represented in the Festival. In 1897, the vicar of Muker in Swaledale chaired a public meeting which decided to form a brass band to mark Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee. Since then, the Muker Silver Band has survived the challenges of war, population movement and social change and maintained the village's tradition of music-making. A strong sense of local identity and family loyalty has enabled the continue despite Muker's to population; most of the players, whose ages range from 10 to 70, still hail from within a few miles of the village. The ever popular Muker

Silver Band, conducted by Duncan Bythell, appears at Muker Village Hall on Wednesday 2nd June and Friday 4th June. Over the moors. in neighbouring Wensleydale, the Leyburn Band re-formed late in 2003 after closing ten years earlier. Their earliest record goes back to 1841 when the Band played for the Leyburn Shawl Tea Festival organised by the Wensleydale Temperance Society. The current band has an action-packed programme, an enthusiastic local following and has recorded two well-received CDs. Musical Director George Lundberg will take a musical journey with the band in St Matthew's Church, Leyburn on Tuesday 1st June. The Hawes Silver Prize Brass Band, directed by Stan Roocroft, will perform traditional and modern favourites at St Margaret's Church, Hawes on Saturday 12th June. Stan is the President of the Wensleydale Tournament of Song, an annual competition which has run for over 100 years, the Gayle Chapel Choir and the Wensleydale Philharmonic Orchestra. Most of the 30-plus members of Reeth Brass live in Reeth or nearby villages and are drawn from all sections of that local community. No Swaledale Festival is complete without them playing at Grinton Church where they will offer a collection of traditional and modern favourites on Tuesday 8th June. And finally, the Barnard Castle Band - founded in 1860 - will be providing free entertainment outside St Mary's Church, Barnard Castle, on Sunday 13th June, as part of the Festival's first ever Barnard Castle Day. The Swaledale Festival runs from 29th May to 13th June, packing a summer fortnight with an exciting programme which includes classical and folk music, jazz, poetry, art exhibitions and guided walks in stunning scenery. Events take place in intimate venues throughout northern Dales of Swaledale, Wensleydale and Arkengarthdale in North Yorkshire, and rural Teesdale in County Durham. 


