an EMERGENCY People are often confused as to what is and what isn't an emergency; and when or if to call the emergency services. The simple answer is: IF IN DOUBT - CALL 999. concerned that sometimes patients call the surgery to alert the doctors before calling for an ambulance. REMEMBER: 999 first Doctor second One of the doctors will come to you as soon as possible, but vital time can be lost waiting for one of us to arrive when an ambulance can already be on the way, carrying life-saving equipment. Dr Anderson or I may be with another patient, out visiting or out of mobile telephone range. Your message will reach us as soon as possible, but in a lifesituation, the threatening emergency services are the first and best course of action. I know some of you may think 'I don't want to bother the emergency services'. Please don't worry. ambulance service will take all the details. Their staff are trained to assess the urgency of the situation. An ambulance can always be cancelled if ultimately it is not required, but it is vital to be safe than sorry. ON LINE APPOINTMENTS already order you your prescriptions on-line. This is proving to be mutually beneficial as prescriptions can be processed more effectively. From now on, you can also book Doctors appointments for the Monday, Wednesday and Friday

Where to begin? Lots of prescription ordering, you will require your log-in and password to use this facility. Just ask Janice or Vicki, our Receptionists, who will organise this for you. CONTACT BY E-MAIL & BLOGGING Whilst I'm in the technological vein, some of you have given us your email addresses for ease and speed of contact. As with all other personal details, these are held in the strictest confidence and will not be divulged to any other party. ### GOOD NEWS FROM ST. MARYS **ARKENGARTHDALE**

The first phase of the refurbishment of the windows at St. Mary's Arkengarthdale was completed in time for Christmas. The stonework to the crumbling East window and to all the windows on the North side of the church was replaced and the rare cast iron frames refurbished so that they should last for another 100 years. The members of the church are very grateful to all the Dalesfolk who generously gave money and support to this major venture and to visitors and those scattered supporters who also contributed. We also recognise the tremendous help received from English Heritage who not only gave advice but also granted us over half the cost of the repairs. We are now considering the repairs to the South windows which are in a similar state of distress to those on the North before their repair. Since we have, as expected, expended all the funds raised for the first phase, we have applied to English Heritage for a 100% grant for the second phase. We have recently heard that application has cleared the first hurdle and we hope that we shall be sufficiently successful to allow the replacement of the South windows to take place during the



warning though after cleaning you will need to log back into websites that you regularly visit - if you want to avoid that untick "cookies" on the left (it is listed for each browser you may use, Internet Explorer, Opera or Google Alternatively, and better, use the options to set the cookies you don't want to delete automatically. (Another warning - unless you know what you are doing avoid using the Registry Cleaner on the left). Tools on the left gives guick access if you want to uninstall any programs you don't use.

### A Piece Of Swaledale History

A piece of Swaledale history has been returned to the dale and put into the care of the local museum by the Swaledale Festival - and it's all a bit of a mystery! In the early part of the last century Swaledale, like Wensleydale, had its own 'Tournament of Song' in which local choirs competed for a fine shield which recorded their victories on plagues which were added each year. Earlier this year, while an old barn near Topcliffe was being cleared out, the Swaledale Tournament of Song Shield came to light after being hidden for decades under agricultural grime; but no one knows its history or how it got there. It was handed over to keen Rotarian Alan Nuttall, in the expectation that if any organisation knew what to do with it, it would be the Rotary Club with its network of members and contacts. Alan's first thought was that came from as

Swaledale it ought to go back there and, seeing that the Richmond Musical Society had won the the Shield in 1934 and 1935. he searched for them on the Internet. That search quickly took him to the website of the Richmondshire Choral Society and its current chairman. Janet Hall, who was asked if the choir would like to have the shield. Janet explained that there was nowhere for the Society to display it. However, Janet discussed the Shield with fellow board members of the Swaledale Festival, and it was decided that the best home for it would be the Swaledale Museum in Reeth. The Shield design is appropriate for instrumentalists as well as singers, as it is decorated with an embossed silver crest depicting brass instruments, along with a tiny musical score of the National Anthem. Former winners of the Shield, between 1908 and 1937, include the Mowbray Chorus, Northallerton Music Society, Thirsk Choral Society, Catterick Choral Society and Northallerton Congregational Choir. The top plague - for 1907 - is missing; could this be the first year of the Tournament and, if so, who were the winners? And there the mystery deepens: what was the Swaledale Tournament of Song? and how did the Shield get into a barn in Topcliffe? "It's a very handsome shield and a bit of a puzzle", said Swaledale Museum curator Helen Clifford. "We would love to hear from anyone who has any information about the Swaledale Tournament of Song, its history, or photographs of the winning choirs." Helen can he emailed museum.swaledale@btinternet.com. and the Shield will be on display when the Museum re-opens at Easter 2010.


