Marrick Parish Council

At the Annual Meeting of the Council held 2010 Councillor 13 May Braithwaite was elected Chair and Councillor Mark Hodgson Vice-Chair, Mrs Pauline Cordner would continue as Parish Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer and Mr David Trusson as Internal Auditor. of the review Audit Plan and of Effectiveness Internal Audit was carried out. Α more detailed Risk Assessment, prepared by the Clerk, was examined and accepted. Following a review of policies, it was agreed no changes were necessary. Future meetings of the Parish Council would continue to be held bimonthly at Marrick Institute, County Councillor John Blackie attended the Parish Council Meeting which followed. NYCC Review of Passenger Transport Services and Home to School Transport led to a lengthy discussion. Councillor Blackie commented on the excellent Dial-aride service. Councillors expressed their dissatisfaction with the current system of winter maintenance. Transport problems caused by the severe winter weather were related to Councillor Blackie, who informed the meeting that a review of the gritting policy was taking place and that highways supervisors were to have more flexibility in the provision of salt bins and salt piles. Summary of Accounts for financial year was approved. consideration was given to the internal auditor's report, which provided the assurances necessary for the Council to complete its annual governance statement. Annual Return completed. was Discussing North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service's Integrated Risk Plan, Councillor Blackie Management stressed the importance of retaining the

services in Reeth and Hawes. Planning permission had been granted for the revised scheme of conversion of building to form dwelling, Low Greenas, Hurst and for erection of high ropes activity course, climbing wall and river crossing, Marrick Priory Outdoor Education Centre. There were no objections to the erection of a purpose agricultural Harland House, Marrick, North Yorkshire County Council had forwarded an amended draft version of the Parish Charter. Permission would be given for the use of parish land for the Scott Trial on 23 October 2010. Date of next meeting 29 July 2010 at Marrick Institute.

The Swaledale & Arkengarthdale Luncheon Club Association was formed in 1994 to organise regular monthly lunches in Langthwaite, Low Row, Muker and Reeth. The meals are provided by local caterers (Lisa Porter and helpers), and transport to the clubs is provided by the Ring to Ring Community Minibus and Harker's Coaches of Reeth, Members pay £7 for a three course lunch, but the Club also has to cover the costs of hiring the village halls, providing the transport, printing menus and publicity, and occasional

equipment items. The Club receives very welcome donations from various sources to help cover these additional costs, but the committee is always looking for other sources of potential sponsorship. Councillor Blackie said: "The Club is a beacon example of self-reliance within the deeply rural community that is the Upper It also provides an unrivalled Dales. opportunity for some treasured networking amongst those attending, who are drawn from hugely dispersed and often very remote and isolated areas, and this aspect of its social inclusion must never be underestimated. DEEP VEIN THROMBOSIS (DVT)

The holiday you booked six months ago is now about to start. The factor 50 sun cream is

with packed. along the bikinis swimming trunks. You arrive at the airport in good time. Plenty of time, in fact, to have a few beers or a couple of large gin and tonics before take off. Once in the air the cabin crew bring you a few more drinks to get you in the holiday mood. All this sounds wonderful, but a word of (Dr Killjoy again!) combined with flying is not a good mix. Both cause the body to dehydrate, and dehydration can be a major cause of Deep Vein Thrombosis (DVT).

So, what is DVT? DVT occurs when a blood clot blocks a deep vein in the body, obstructing or stopping the flow of blood. Family history and obesity also have an impact on a person's susceptibility to DVT, as does inactivity - the very thing that we have no control over on a flight. In particular, a long haul flight.

How will I know if I get DVT? As the blood clots form, a sensation of cramp or a dull ache may be experienced. Gradually, the skin may become tight and feel hot. This should not be ignored. Part of a clot may break off and get into one of the arteries near the heart, which could cause a Pulmonary Embolism - potentially a lifethreatening situation. You can be affected by DVT in situations other than flying. If you are sitting all day, tied to a computer and drinking lots of coffee, again, this is not a good combination.

Prevention is better than cure T h e important thing is to keep moving and drink lots of water - especially when flying. The airlines provide exercise sheets to keep you moving, and some even provide flight socks, so do make use of them. It only remains for me to say: 'Bon Voyage!'

DOCTOR APPOINTMENTS FOR VISITORS

Even on holiday we can become ill and need to urgently see a doctor, and in the rigmarole of packing, sometimes the little things get left behind - like medication! If you are visiting the area, the doctors at Reeth Medical Centre will be very happy to register you as a temporary patient if you are in need of urgent medical attention or require a supply of medication until you can obtain more from your own doctor. The surgery times are available at the Tourist Information Centre or call us on 01748 884396.Please be aware that we cannot sell you things like paracetamol, ibuprofen or dressings but these are available from the shops in the area. 



Computer Corner with Carol Haynes

What's in a name? I often get calls where I try to help people over the telephone with a computer problem. As I described in a previous article I can connect to computers over the internet and it is often easier to have a quick look to find out what is going on rather than ask a lot of questions. The program that allows me to do this has to be downloaded first onto their computer so I ask customers to open their browser and go to www.teamviewer.com to download install the required remote control software. Frequently this has led to a long exchange where it is clear that what they are looking at is not the Teamviewer website but rather a list of results from Google. Often when asked "which browser are you using?" the answer comes back So I thought it interesting to look at what a browser is, how to go to a particular webpage and why choosing a browser is important. If you are using Windows you automatically have Internet Explorer installed (on the Mac it Safari). Often people use these browsers because of the law of least resistance - they are there and generally you just have to click on them to get them to work. You aren't, however, restricted to using the one you started with and generally you are better off using an alternative but this involves a little work (well - under 2 minutes if you have favourite is Mozilla broadband). Mγ from Firefox (you can download it www.mozilla.com) because it has lots of useful extensions (including ones that

block adverts - which makes the internet less annoying, and check your spelling when you fill in forms). Additionally Firefox works on almost any computer - Windows, Mac and Linux so once you are used to Firefox you can use it in exactly the same way on any computer you come across. There are lots of others to choose from such as Google Chrome, Opera etc. (do a search on the names to find out more) and a recent Microsoft update pops up a window so you can choose (if you haven't seen it then it means your computer is not up to date). Once you have your chosen browser installed you can choose to use it or go back to your old browser if you like so there is nothing to lose by trying out a new one. Whichever you choose, when you open the browser it generally displays your chosen 'homepage' (which you can choose for yourself in the 'options' window) and many people have this set automatically to Google Search which has a big box where you can type in the middle of the screen and hence the confusion. To go to a specific website, rather than search for something using Google, look at the very top of the window. There is usually a smaller bar with the webpage address, and you can change it. If you have Google on may look like: it www.google.co.uk. This is where you can type the actual page you are looking for. So if you are looking for BBC iPlayer just click in that box (the text generally turns blue) and start typing - which clears the existing address and starts with the new address (if the old one doesn't disappear use the delete key to delete it before you start typing). . You don't need to include the http:// bit - just type www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer and press "Enter" (or "Return") on your keyboard and hey presto you go straight to the right page More on getting the most from browsers next month ... plus a competition! 




