

Christian Aid Emergency Appeal for Haiti Thanks very much indeed for the generous response to the Haiti Appeal. The Soup and Sandwich lunch at Cogden Hall on January 28th raised £803.38. The collection taken at the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity Service at Reeth Methodist Church on January 24th was £278.92 giving a total of £1082.30 with an addition of over £150 claimable through Gift Aided donations. Christian Aid and its partners are working on sourcing and distributing food, tents, hygiene kits, blankets, jerry cans for water and water purifiers for more than 15,000 people in eight communities. They are targeting areas that are getting little help from other agencies and distributions have already started in Leogane, Darbonne and Delmas 33. Christian Aid are also funding medical supplies, both inside Haiti and for the tent hospitals at the Haiti/ Dominican Republic border. A disaster of this scale poses exceptional challenges for aid agencies, and Christian Aid are drawing on lessons learned from their tsunami response. RED ALERT FOR DANGER -National Park extension proposals

An innocuous consultation document could signal doom and disaster for having your voice heard at the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority (YDNPA) and including on the very important Planning Committee which makes so many decisions that impact on everyday life here in the Upper Dales.

In prospect then is a return to the bad old days before 1997 when there were nearly no local representatives on the National Park and insensitive planning decisions were made by people who did not live or work here, and had little comprehension of the key issues for those of us who do.

The document is the Natural England Consultation "Lakes to Dales Landscape Designation Project" which proposes to extend the boundaries of the National Park, further into Cumbria, right up to the M6 at Tebay, and also into Lancashire. It makes clear if the proposed extensions go ahead the membership of the YDNPA would have to be "re-distributed". County and 2 District Councillors from North Yorkshire would be removed. Their places would be taken by a Lancashire County Councillor, a Lancashire City Councillor and two others from Cumbria. The Upper Dales County Council division would lose its place, and its 5500 electors resident in the National Park would be disenfranchised at the YDNPA, and their place taken by just 200 electors in the National Park represented by a Lancashire County Councillor. Richmondshire District Councillor with 1150 electors all in the National Park would be replaced by a Lancaster City Councillor with just 100

electors within the extended boundary. Iniquitous, you might say !! I say so on behalf of everybody in the Upper Dales. Your all-important planning application could very well be refused on the deciding vote of a Lancaster Councillor living 50 miles or more away. It is not local decision making is it?? If the boundaries were extended then 30% of the National Park would be in Cumbria, and there is an increasing clamour from communities in the proposed new areas for the word "Yorkshire" to be dropped from the official title "Yorkshire Dales National Park". The very suggestion of losing the centuries old association between the internationally acclaimed landscapes in the Dales and the geographical location of Yorkshire, has caused outright dismay and disbelief by all those with a Yorkshire pedigree by birth, adoption or affection. It also threatens to dilute the very strong brandina built around tourism Yorkshire Dales. with disastrous implications for employment and prosperity in our local Dales economies. I have won the overwhelming support of North Yorkshire County Council, Richmondshire District Council, and many Dales Parish Councils, to object very strongly on both the loss of representation and the name change. 



Hi, my name is Stuart Grainger and I'd like to take this opportunity to introduce myself to you as the new Sergeant for the Dales Policing area, based in

Leyburn. My area extends from Patrick Brompton in the east, to as far as the Moorcock Inn and Tan Hill in the west, and from Arkengarthdale in the north to the head of Coverdale in the south. It is a great privilege to be in charge of a policing team which covers such a large and special area. I know the area pretty well geographically from being a keen cyclist, but I'm now learning who's who and what's what so to speak. The Upper and Lower Dales includes a total of 53 parishes, and I have already begun attending a good number of parish and town council meetings to introduce myself and ask what issues there are in the community. It is very important to me that we police this area in a way in which the people want it to be policed. It is also very important to me that early on, I tap into the issues which affect all of you in your local communities - so that we can do something about them and help you. I will continue to visit as many public meetings as possible in my first few months, and will try to meet as many people as I possibly can. If I don't see you and you have a burning issue that you'd like to raise, then please get in touch with myself or one of the team. We are here to Richmondshire The Neighbourhood Team web pages on the North Yorkshire Police website also has a calendar showing where and when we will be getting out and about at meetings and events. I feel very lucky that I have inherited a great team of police officers and staff. I'm impressed with their local knowledge and commitment to this area. There are already a good number of initiatives on the go, such as

Daleswatch, RAMP. youth initiatives, Smartwater, Trading Standards and other partnership work, and so on - and I'm keen to build on these. The support that volunteers the Daleswatch give tremendous, and I'm also keen to expand this into the Lower Dales area - so volunteers please....! The Leyburn policing area is a safe place to live where crime rates are low - but I fully appreciate the impact of any crime on the individual so I will not be complacent in tackling crime. Crime figures may be higher elsewhere, but figures don't always tell the full story - how do 10 shoplifting thefts in York or Scarborough for example, compare to the loss of one quad bike or essential piece of farm equipment in our area? Our crime is low - but it is impactive when it happens - so I will do my very best to keep it as low as possible. Please ring in if you see or hear anything suspicious on 999 if urgent, or 0845 6060247 if non-urgent. I know from experience that we can quite literally patrol round all night and not see a single vehicle moving to stopcheck - and not for the want of trying. But, if someone rings in about something suspicious, then it gives us a headstart, and allows us to focus in on an area and root out and stopcheck travelling criminals before they commit crime in your neighbourhood, or disturb or catch them in the act. I look forward to serving the communities of the Lower and Upper Dales and I hope you find me to be as hardworking, approachable, and genuine as I have always found the people of the Dales to be.

Two quick items this month to try to keep your computer fit and healthy (and yourself sane):

1) A BIG Warning

There is a large growth on the internet in scam security programs. Over the last month I have helped clean numerous computers because of these problems and real security firms are warning users to be very careful. If this happens to you the symptoms are that a program you have never seen before or knowingly installed constantly pops up and tells you that your computer is subject to multiple threats (often 20 to 30) and that to remove them need to register the security software. This involves supplying credit card details which is what the scammers are really after. Under no circumstances use your credit card online while these problems are on your computer. Removing these scam programs can be quite difficult and the approaches required are varied so I can't give instructions here. To avoid these problems do not click on any links in emails or websites that you are unsure of. If you download software do so from reputable websites and avoid running any program that you are unsure of that has been downloaded onto your computer. Note that some of these scams are not picked up by anti-virus software and sneak through - they can even disable your existing protection.

2) Update your computer.

Many people have Windows set to automatically download updates and install

them. Generally this is recommended but if that is all you do you are missing out on many updates and also extra software. Automatic update only installs updates that Microsoft consider Important or Critical. You do need to visit Microsoft Update to get these extra updates and do this fairly regularly (say once a month). How you do this depends on the version of Windows on your computer. In Windows XP go to Start>All Programs>Windows Update or load Internet Explorer and look in the Tools Menu. You need to use the Custom button to see the extra updates available. In Windows Vista and Windows 7, go to Start>Computer and then click System Properties in the window that opens (near top left) then click Windows Update near the bottom left hand corner - clicking Check for Updates will give you lists of important and optional updates. Windows Update offers you the new Microsoft Update accept that as it will update other Microsoft products such as Word and Excel. New exhibition at Dales Countryside Museum

A new exhibition featuring the beauty of Swaledale is being staged for visitors to the Dales Countryside Museum in Hawes later this month (Feb). Called "Small Dale World - A Village in View", it is a collection of photographs, watercolours and drawings by writer and photographer David Morgan Rees centred on Marske near Richmond. In recent years the 80year-old has devoted much of his time to documenting the basic realities of Marske, where he had a cottage for more than 30 years. "My images in this exhibition are my own way of expressing the depth of my feelings for the local landscape, activities and atmosphere of this very special place," he said. "I also felt it was very important to make a comprehensive visual record of a rural community at a particular period in the late 20th century. "My years spent in a small cottage just outside the village have been perhaps the happiest and most fulfilling part of my life. I felt welcome from the first moment I arrived in Marske. It was made so easy for me to join in village life and participate in various activities and events. I was never made to feel I was an outsider. This gave me a remarkably close relationship with many people who I continue to regard as friends although sadly I have had to move away."

He has written for a variety of publications, including The Dalesman, Yorkshire Journal and Yorkshire Life. As well as having worked as a radio freelance in the past for BBC Wales he three published books: 'Yorkshire Craftsmen at Work' a survey in his words and photographs of traditional Yorkshire craftsmen, 'In the Palm of a Dale', a detailed portrait of Marske at the Millennium, where he bought a small cottage in 1973. His last book, 'Our Small Dale World', is a valediction and celebration in words and images of the time he spent at Marske, which so enriched his life.

exhibition runs from 27 February to 28 March in the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority-owned Museum. Museum Manager Fiona Rosher said: "The exhibition is a very personal look at a Dales village from David's point of view and it captures perfectly the essence of the community."

The hunt is on for historic dovecotes in the Yorkshire Dales.

And owners of the up-market accommodation for doves and pigeons are being asked to get in touch with the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority (YDNPA) to help in a special new conservation project. Robert White, Authority's Senior Conservation Archaeologist, said: "Dovecotes played an important part in rural life in the National Park, "The birds they housed provided their owners with many resources, including eggs and meat for food, feathers for bedding - and even fertiliser. "We want to hear from people who have them whether they are built into their houses or outbuildings or are freestanding - because, if we can identify more examples and increase our knowledge of their design and distribution, we will be able to improve the ways we can conserve and protect them in the future. "Not all of them have survived so we would also be interested in any documentary records."

Dovecotes are put under the microscope in the YDNPA's Feature of the Season Project, which was designed to increase understanding and appreciation of unrecorded, small-scale historic features in the National Park ranging from unusual gate posts and churn stands to veteran trees and turbary stones. The project aims to create accessible records of them - mainly through the help of Dales Volunteers - that are included in the National Park Authority's Historic Environment Record.



VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED FOR Community First Responder Scheme in

Reeth, Grinton and the surrounding areas

Yorkshire Ambulance Service (YAS) is looking for volunteers in the Reeth, Grinton and Surrounding areas to join the Community First Responder scheme. Community First Responders are volunteers who provide immediate lifesaving care to members of their communities in an emergency medical situation, such as heart attack, breathing difficulties or a collapse, in the vital minutes before the ambulance arrives. They are trained in Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) which delivers a controlled electric shock to restart the heart. First Responders also carry portable oxygen. Dave Jones, Community Defibrillation Trainer for YAS in North Yorkshire, said: "Community First Responders make a valuable contribution to their communities. We know that in many medical emergencies the first few minutes are critical. If effective treatment can be performed within those first minutes, lives can be saved and disability reduced. Being a First Responder can be extremely rewarding and I would encourage anyone who may be interested in taking on the role to get in touch. "Many people volunteer as a Community First Responder to gain experience, to help their local communities and some people have had personal experience of a loved one needing prompt medical attention and can see the value in this initiative. Volunteers come from all walks of life." Full training is given to successful applicants who need to be over 18, physically fit and hold a full driving licence having never been banned from driving with no more than three penalty points.
