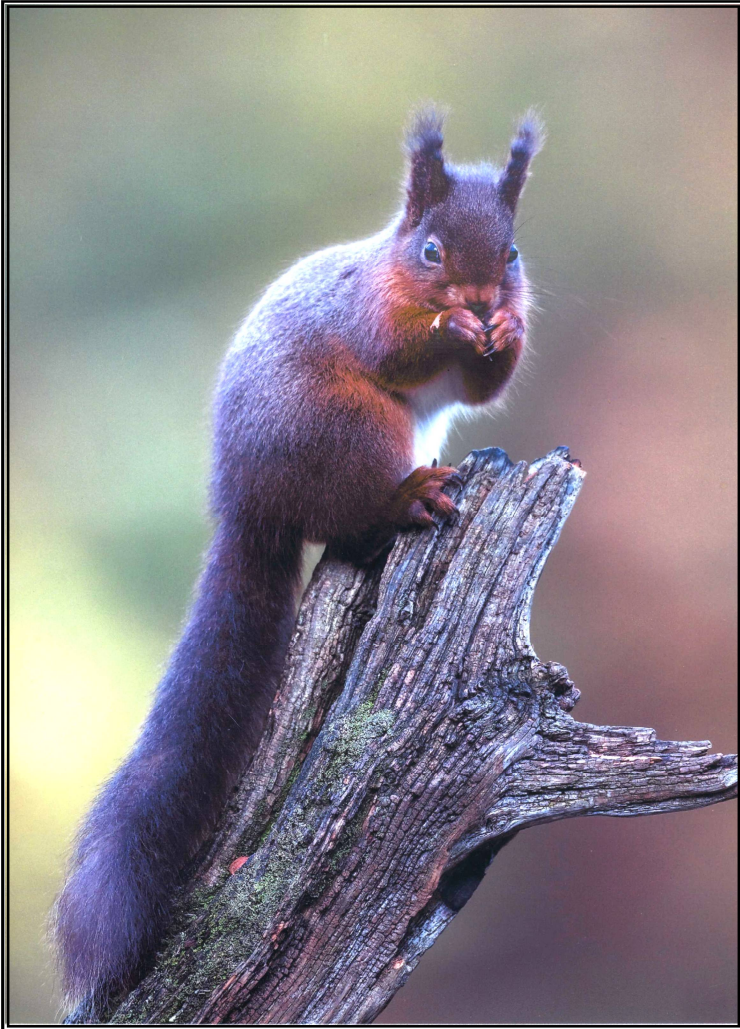

### Crime in the Two Dales

Last month we received a report of a suspect person and vehicle around the area of Marrick. In Reeth damage was caused to a vehicle and in Grinton a vehicle was broken into and property removed. Volunteer members of the public and members of the Richmondshire District Council and the police will be conducting an Environmental Visual Audit in the area of Low Row, on foot, so any problems or concerns you have in the area can be discussed and pointed out. Letters have been distributed inviting residents to declare their interest in attending. The venue, date and time, yet to be confirmed via posters and updating members of the local Parish Council. The history and stories behind the Quaker Tapestry was the subject of our April meeting. The tapestry, comprising 77 panels of embroidery, was begun in 1981. Since 1994 it has been exhibited in Kendal at the Friends Meeting House, with a travelling exhibition each February. Often compared to the Bayeux Tapestry, the Quaker Tapestry is a celebration of life, people and events associated with Friends across the centuries. Many of the panels were designed by children and over four thousand people, at Friends' meetings around the country, undertook the embroidery, which includes a newly devised stitch, the Quaker Stitch. The end result is a fascinating, colourful and inspirational tapestry. Many of us resolved to see the Tapestry for ourselves the next time we visit Kendal. For May and June we will be visiting Grewelthorpe Gardens and Whitby, and holding our mid summer tea. 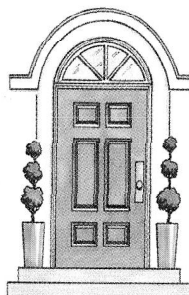

WINTER GRITTING-an UPDATE ON POLICY

County Councillor John Blackie has pursued a number of various issues relating to the winter gritting policy, that had been exposed in the freeze-up, at two North Yorkshire County Council Richmondshire Area Committees recently. He also raised these issues at County Council in February. He never seems to give up trying !! Councillor Blackie acknowledged each time he raised the issues, the totally committed contributions made by the front-line staff on the gritters, the fantastic resource that were the two trailer-gritters here in the Upper Dales (Robert Stones and Peter Iveson in Upper Wensleydale) and the invaluable help from the farmers who are part time contractors for the County. However, he said, despite their wonderful efforts, the policy is not meeting the needs or expectations of deeply rural communities it is there to serve, and it needed reviewing. Other County Councillors agreed with him, and a review is taking place. Here is where they are so far in the review: 1) NYCC have agreed with his suggestion to buy 2 additional trailer-gritters, one to be based at Gunnerside, and one in Leyburn serving the Aysgarth and West Burton areas as well. This will leave Robert Stones to concentrate on the triangle formed by Arkengarthdale - Reeth - Low Row in the future but with back-up available for the Low Row up to Keld area from the new Gunnerside trailer-gritter. Mike Woodford has the cash to buy these trailer-gritters which will be in place for this coming winter. 2) It appears following Councillor Blackie's pressure via the Press and on local radio, the County have been able to address the red / white diesel issue that prevented

farmer contractors undertaking snow ploughing from gritting at the same time. There are now 3 letters of comfort saying HM Customs and Excise would regard the extreme conditions we had this winter as exceptional and grant a general dispensation to farmers using red diesel and dealing with snow and ice and gritting under the directions of the County Council. Common sense in a Central Government department has prevailed at long last !! 3) The ridiculous salt bin / salt pile policy will be heavily amended as an outcome of the review to provide much more flexibility in the provision of these items. Communities like ours in the Upper Dales are hugely self-reliant and resourceful, and do not mind helping themselves in times of crisis, but they need the tools of the trade - salt, grit, etc to do this. In any case this self-help reduces the pressure on the gritters. This relaxation of the policy should then address the issues people have, for example, where delays in replenishing the salt piles trapped people in their homes when, if there had been salt / grit available they would have been able to get mobile. 4) Salt spread rates (at times not enough to deal with the snow/ice), having local control of the gritting operation from within the Dales when conditions become extreme, rather than some distance away, greater flexibility of which roads need to be gritted day after day when sometimes they could be left and more minor rural roads tackled instead - all points John Blackie, along with others, have raised - will be dealt with later in the review. In short we are getting somewhere, and a further report will be issued once the review is completed.



### PATIENT TRANSPORT

You may or may not be aware that a non-emergency transport service is available to

take eligible patients to and from hospital and clinic appointments. This is known as **Patient Transport Services**. There are strict criteria as to who can access this service, however, and to avoid confusion, I thought I would try and clarify the process.

#### **"Am I eligible for transport?"**

You can request patient transport if you:

- Need a stretcher for the journey
- Need oxygen during the journey
- Are permanently wheelchair bound
- Have a mental health problem, learning disability, speech, sight or hearing difficulty preventing you using public transport
- Cannot walk without relying on another person or a walking aid and have no-one to accompany you
- Have side effects from your treatment or condition that prevents you using public transport

Obviously, it is important that the service is available to those who really need it, so please consider these points before booking. **How to access Patient Transport Services**

Patients are responsible for arranging their own transport for appointments. This is done by ringing the call centre on 0845 056 7060. You will need to have your postcode, address, phone number and date and time and location of the appointment to hand. The call centre is open Monday to Friday from 8am until 6pm and must be contacted as soon as possible to arrange transport (for appointments the following day, you must ring before 12.00

noon). From time to time, some people have left their booking too late, and the transport service has been unable to cope. A guide to this service is available from Reeth Medical Centre, so just request a leaflet from our Receptionists. **PUBLIC TRANSPORT** Richmondshire District Council has recently reviewed the public transport service to and from hospitals and is seeking to reduce the number of time-table clashes and long waiting times that can sometime be experienced when travelling to appointments at Darlington or Northallerton. I am hoping this review will improve upon the situation for those of you who rely on public transport to get to hospital. We are also fortunate to have the 'Ring to Ride' service through the Reeth District Community Transport Project. This service can be used for a variety of needs, including hospital appointments and visiting. 'Ring to Ride' is a membership only scheme, it costs £1 per year to join and anyone in the community can join. The rest of the first half was even with good defending by Will Fawcett and Dan Longden. In 2<sup>nd</sup> half, Adam scored 2 good goals while the whole team were playing and passing much better. Askrigg continued to attack and Peter While made some good saves. The fourth goal came from a strong shot by Harry Hughes. We had other chances and kept the Askrigg keeper busy. Won 4-0. On April 6<sup>th</sup> we travelled to Barton for 2 evening League matches. Adam opened the scoring to be followed by another from Harry. Our defenders were then caught too far up the field enabling Barton to score and they equalised from a penalty. Barton then conceded a penalty taken by Sean. ## Computer Corner

with Carol Haynes

### Security (again!)

I have spent a large part of my time in the last month cleaning up infected computers. A couple of months ago I warned of fake security programs on the internet and since that article I have been inundated with requests to clean up the resulting havoc. Let me reiterate the warning: there are a number of variations on a theme so it isn't easy to give a precise set of things to look out for but by far the commonest issue is when you are browsing the internet a popup window appears saying your computer is at risk. You are then prompted to click a button to clean your computer (or a decline button) - don't click either button they both seem to install the same fake security program. The best thing to do is to close your browser by right clicking on the taskbar icon (at the bottom of the screen) and select "Close". This will force the window to close without activating the nasty behind the buttons. Alternatively use the Task Manager to close the browser (press CONTROL / ALT / DELETE and the Task Manager opens in XP but in Vista/7 you then click Task Manager). Select the applications tab and click on the browser tasks currently running then click End Task at the bottom and allow the application to close. Note that there are about 50 variations of this pest that affect Windows XP, Vista and 7 and they do a good job at masking their presence by disabling standard security features in Windows and replacing them with very similar looking versions of their own. The aim of the scam is to get you to part with credit card details and for some reason I have yet to find a real

security suite that protects computers against this plague (I have seen infected computers running all the common security apps: Norton, MacAfee, Avira, Avast, Panda, Kapersky etc.) so please don't feel complacent that you are protected.

Accessing your computer away from home ... Many people want to access their own computer when they are using a laptop away from home. The simplest way I have found is to use a program called Team Viewer ([www.teamviewer.com](http://www.teamviewer.com)), free for non-commercial use. Many of my customers have seen me use this to access their computers remotely to identify problems or to show them how to do something without having to get in the car - but it can do much more. Go to Team Viewer and download the program ("Start Full Version") and install it on your home computer. Choose "Start Automatically with Windows" and choose a secure password that you can use to access your computer later. Now select "Full Access" and complete the installation. When the program runs make a note of the ID (this is unique to your computer) which is needed with the password you chose to access the computer. When you are away you can access your computer (so long as it is switched on and connected to the internet) by going to [teamviewer.com](http://teamviewer.com) and click "Web Login" at the top. First time you will need to set up an account (free) and once logged in you can use your home computer ID and password to view you home computer screen and control it just like you were at home. You can also transfer files to and from the computer you are using. Hope this has been helpful. THE SWALEDALE FESTIVAL

The world première of music commissioned to celebrate the 30th anniversary of the Swaledale Festival brings together a composer and a musician who both live in Wensleydale. The composer David Blake was born in London and has lived in Yorkshire for nearly 50 years. Following National Service he learnt Mandarin Chinese and spent a year in Hong Kong. He went on to read music at Caius College, Cambridge, where his teachers included the conductor and harpsichordist Raymond Leppard. He was awarded the Mendelssohn Scholarship for Composition in 1960, and, uniquely for a British composer of his generation, he went to East Berlin to study with Arnold Schoenberg's pupil, the Marxist composer Hanns Eisler. David Blake was awarded the Granada Arts Fellowship in 1963 at the newly opened University of York, and the following year, with Wilfrid Mellers and Peter Aston, he founded the University's Department of Music. He was Lecturer in Music in the Department until 1976, when he succeeded Wilfrid Mellers as Professor. Since retirement in 2001, he has lived in the Wensleydale village of Askrigg. His most recent works, for the stage, include *Scoring a Century* - "low entertainment for highbrows, or vice versa" - and two commissions for English National Opera. Robert Saxton, one of Britain's leading composers, says of him: "David Blake is an example of an increasingly rare breed of creator. He is one of the few contemporary composers who still write powerfully expressive counterpoint, and his melodic invention, ability to characterise musical ideas and his gift of music drama

combine to make him a complete artist." On Wednesday 2 June David Blake's *5th String Quartet* will be given its world première by the Fitzwilliam Quartet at St Oswald's Church, Askrigg, the village where it was composed. David Blake was one of the Swaledale Festival's founder Board members. Further down Wensleydale, in the village of Bellerby, lives Jonathan Sparey of the Fitzwilliam Quartet, which celebrates its 40th anniversary this year. Born in Keswick, Jonathan Sparey won a scholarship to the Royal Manchester College of Music. He joined the Fitzwilliam in 1974, taking part in all their foreign tours and recordings, and receiving an Honorary Doctorate of Music at Bucknell University, Pennsylvania - conferred by Dmitri Shostakovich's son, Maxim. He has since also played in the Yorkshire Baroque Soloists and other chamber groups. Jonathan has held violin teaching posts at institutions including the University of York and Chetham's School of Music, Manchester. He has a deep knowledge and passion for instruments and bows, and many of his fine collection are on loan to students and young professionals. His own current violin was made in the Antonio Stradivari workshop in Cremona, Italy, in 1731. The Fitzwilliam Quartet's members joined forces in 1968 during their inaugural term at Cambridge, and after graduation went straight to their first professional appointment, as Resident Quartet at York University, succeeding the Amadeus Quartet. There they quickly achieved worldwide recognition through their close association with Dmitri Shostakovich, who befriended them

following a visit to hear them give the British première of his 13th Quartet. Later, following Shostakovich's death in 1975, Benjamin Britten said Shostakovich had told him the Fitzwilliam were his "preferred performers of my quartets". Having introduced his last three quartets to the West, the Fitzwilliam soon became the first ensemble to record and perform all fifteen, and their recordings (now reissued for a third time) gained many international awards. Ten years into a new Residency, at Fitzwilliam College Cambridge, the Fitzwilliam remains one of the very few string quartets in Britain using period instruments. Unusually, the members sometimes perform on both early and modern instruments within the same concert. The Fitzwilliam Quartet appears twice at this year's Swaledale Festival. As well as the David Blake première, the Quartet's concert at Askrigg on 2 June includes works by Glazunov, Schnittke and Beethoven, and Barber's Quartet Op 11. The Fitzwilliam Quartet appears again on Thursday 3 June at St Andrew's Church, Grinton playing Mozart's famous 'Hunt' Quartet and works by Suk, Delius and Sibelius. The Swaledale Festival runs from 29 May to 13 June, packing a summer fortnight with an exciting programme which includes classical and folk music, jazz, poetry, art exhibitions and guided walks in stunning scenery. Events take place in intimate venues throughout the northern Dales of Swaledale, Wensleydale and Arkengarthdale in North Yorkshire, and rural Teesdale in County Durham. Other highlights of the 2010 Festival include Emma Kirkby, Peter Donohoe, Northern Sinfonia, Natalie Clein, Calefax

Reed Quintet, Carlton Main Frickley Colliery Band, Niamh Ni Charra, Red Priest, poet Jenny Joseph, and Brian Sewell, who gives the Reeth Lecture.
