WILD BOAR AT BOLTON CASTLE!

Take a step back in time at Bolton Castle and witness the incredible sight of Wild Boar emerging from the woodland just as they would have done over 600 years ago in the days when the Castle was first built. As part of an ongoing desire to bring the past to life and enable people to experience as much of what life was like during the Castle's glory days as possible a sounder of nine boar, consisting of two adult sows, plus seven of their offspring have been brought in . The boar arrived on 17th August, but their presence has been kept quiet until now, in order to let them acclimatise to their new surroundings. They have settled in extremely well and delighted with their surroundings, which is exactly the habitat that they would have inhabited in the wild. Wild boar are classified as 'Dangerous Wild Animals' and, in line with legislation, Harrisons of Wensley have built an enclosure of approximately 4 acres, with a perimeter fence five foot high, dug in 18 inches and there is also an internal electric fence, to prevent them burrowing out. Feeding time is around 4.30pm and is proving quite a highlight for many of the



Computer Corner with Carol Haynes

RECOVERING FROM A CATASTROPHEL

Recently I have had to deal with a number of computers where it would no longer start up because the hard disk itself inside computer had become physically damaged. So what can you do to protect yourself from potential problems like this? First a bit of an explanation - there is a lot of confusion over computers and how much memory you have. If you imagine that you are a computer then your brain stores information you are thinking about at any aiven time but after a good night's sleep or a night out on the tiles you may not remember any more. This is like computer memory - it is used while the computer is switched on to hold and information but as soon as the plug is removed everything is forgotten. This is what computer geeks call RAM (random memory) access and most computers now come with 1, 2, 3 or 4 Gigabytes of RAM (usually abbreviated to something like 4Gb). Now if you need to remember things generally people will write it down on paper, dictate it to a tape or get the camera or camcorder out to keep a record for future reference. This is where the computer uses a hard disk and modern computers often have anything hard disks 250*G*b to 1000*G*b installed. Unfortunately hard disks contain both electronics and mechanical moving parts. The mechanical parts spin very fast (typically 7200 times a minute) are very high precision working to an accuracy of millionths of a millimetre. If a small fault occurs (such as a worn bearing) the parts service or non-existent service and the

can bang together and cause physical damage. At this point it is touch and go as to how much of your data (photos, documents, emails etc.) can be recovered. So what is the solution? The answer is to keep regular backups of your system especially important stuff like photos. Nowadays most computers can make DVDs and the blanks are very cheap (typically no more than a £1-£2 depending on the manufacturer) so copying those important photos to a DVD is pretty easy. A very good free program to do this can be downloaded from www.imaburn.com. The problem is that this does not restore your computer to a replacement hard disk if the worst happens. To do that you ideally also need to occasionally make an image backup of your whole system. For this it is ideal to buy an external hard disk that plugs into a USB socket and then use system imaging software to make a complete copy of your hard disk. That way if the worst happens your whole system can be restored quickly to a new internal hard disk. There is some very good free software to do this from http://www.paragon-software.com/home/ db-express/. It is a fairly large download and you do have to install and register the software on your computer but it is well worth the effort. Note if you can't afford to buy an external hard disk you can make a set of backup DVDs but it takes quite a long time and depending on your computer might take a lot of disks. Can you help broadband speed survey? Broadband coverage in the Dales is pretty patchy (at best). I would really like to collect together information about where there is a good service, average service, poor





The 'Mossy Bank' Mystery

Writing is a solitary pastime and so I always look forward to the summer when, for a few weeks, I can relax and enjoy 'the launch'. This summer it began, not with canapés and champagne, but the more down to earth atmosphere of the Reeth and Muker shows. It is the time of year to meet old friends, the regular readers who come for a signed copy of the new book, always ready to tell me what they thought of the previous ones. This year, for the first time, there was also a literary lunch. held at Lewis and Coopers in Northallerton and a signing during the Richmond Walking and Book Festival. I am often told by readers at these events that they like the fact that the books are set in recognisable places in the Dales. No-one has mentioned it yet, but if you read 'Corpse Way' and recognise the villages from Keld down to Grinton, you may be puzzled by 'Mossy Bank' which seems to lie somewhere between Ivelet and Gunnerside but does not appear on any maps. I merely point out that when two murders occur in a hamlet of just a few cottages it's probably best actually does not Arkengarthdale features prominently in 'Craven Scar' and there is a brief reappearance of 'Mossy Bank'. I promise that the Two Dales will be in the next book too. I am frequently asked if it is difficult to think up ideas for my novels. Finding storylines and writing the books is never a problem, only the lack of time. This year I completed the final chapter of 'Craven Scar' in July, leaving just one month for editing, layout and printing before the shows. The cover is always done in a rush so to remedy this we have already been

taking photographs on the moors in preparation for next year's publication! The books have to be distributed across the Dales to bookshops, newsagents, gift shops and teashops - the support from local enterprises has been fantastic. I was delighted when the National Park Centres offered to stock them because I would like to hope that we can encourage readers to explore the areas described in the books. Because the central character, Mills Sanderson, is an archaeologist I have to do quite a bit of research before I will start writing my fifth novel. In the past my books have included topics such as peat bogs, chariot burials, lead mining and lime kilns. My day job as an analytical scientist is useful because it means that I and my business partner [she's also a university professor have worked on a number of forensic cases. including looking for arsenic in the hair of a poison victim, and archaeological studies to authenticate painting and provenance pottery, but I always local rely on experts information specific to the Dales. already have a few ideas for the next book and I am off to find out more about poaching, the Coast to Coast walk, Goths... 
