## LOOK at what you are clicking on - cautionary tales!

LOOK at what you are clicking on! I know it seems obvious but you would be truly amazed at what people do and then wonder what has gone wrong. Actually it isn't really that obvious - many internet pages are now DESIGNED to be confusing. As an example I pointed a customer (no names to save embarrassment) at a page to download a malware scanner to clean up his computer. To my horror the next day he wrote to me and told me the download link on that page installed something completely different - a registry cleaner. It wasn't entirely my fault as the download link he clicked was labelled as an advert (provided you have Superman vision or view your screen with a magnifying glass). Even worse he had run it and it had 'cleaned up' the registry on his computer - something I recommend you never do - registry cleaners almost always do more damage than good! Fortunately it saved a copy of everything it was deleting so we could put it back the way it was. I use an advert blocker on my computer and so didn't see that the page multiple similar looking download buttons (most with microscopic notices that they are adverts). As it happened the software ultimately did no harm but the potential for downloading something nasty is very clear. The solution is to LOOK at what you are clicking on! And yes, get out the magnifying glass or use an advert blocker!

Returning to an old topic with a new twist, fake antivirus software is really becoming endemic and is now also attacking Mac computers (yes they are the ones that Mac users say it is impossible to infect because they are perfect, and Apple actually advertises them that way - wait for the law suits to start rolling in in the US). It took Apple a while to admit there is a problem and now the problem is growing rapidly as it becomes an arms race between Apple and the scammers. Apple released a free tool to clean their systems for users, though how you are supposed to download it once your computer is infected isn't clear. However, the scammers had written a new version of the scam that defeats the removal tool before that tool was even available to the public. Once again the rule with this is LOOK at what you are clicking on!

For anyone who hasn't had the experience of a fake antivirus scam this is what to look out for and an easy way to deal with it. Scenario: you are looking at internet pages when suddenly you are told that an infection has been detected with a "click here" to scan your computer and sort out the problem. Solution: whatever you do don't "click here", don't "click" anywhere except to restart your computer. If there is a genuine infection on your computer it will still be there when it restarts and your antivirus should pop and tell you but clicking on that button will cause a whole heap of trouble. If your computer does accidentally infected the scammers usually have stab at making the window look like it comes from Microsoft or Apple - but it is fake. Whatever you do don't give them credit card details. The solution is LOOK at what you are clicking on in the first place! Have I got a theme this week - anyone

## Medieval world comes alive at the Dales Countryside Museum

Historic happenings aren't unusual at a museum, but visitors to the Yorkshire Dales National Park got a little more than they bargained for. A pike drill led by a fully armoured medieval soldier was just one of the activities at the Dales Countryside Museum in Hawes to celebrate the fifth birthday of the Yorkshire Dales

Young Archaeologists' Club (YDYAC).

The club is for young people interested in history and archaeology and collaboration between the Council for British Archaeology and the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority, which owns the museum. It is based at the museum and sessions have been run almost every month since it began in June, 2006. As part of birthday celebrations. the club welcomed members of the Red Wyvern reenactment group to support this year's theme of medieval life. There was a shoe maker, an apothecary, a fisherman, an archery display, a knights' school and the terrifying pike drill. Club leader Keith Webster said: "The club is a huge success and a credit to our members and leaders. who travel considerable distances to discover more about their past each month. Our annual themes have included prehistory and the Vikings, along with archaeological methods and, of course, the medieval world. It's tremendous fun, and as the majority of the leaders are volunteers, we must get a great deal from it too." Memorable meetings include site visits to Maiden Castle, Ribblehead viaduct, the Jorvik Viking Centre, Coverham Church, the Viking Festival at Burnsall, the Roman Fort at Vindolanda and a Viking longhouse on the flanks of Ingleborough. Sessions at the Museum have included field recording of skeletons, exploring old railways track, building mini roundhouses, creating a stained glass window, knapping flints, using pole lathes, creating felt and even stone carving. Further sessions will include a visit to Bolton Castle and Fountains Abbey, as well as experimenting with heraldry, stonehurling trebuchet catapults and medieval food.



#### Coast to Coast Tractor Run

Chris and Glenda would like to say a huge thank you to everyone who supported Chris' charity tractor run on his Grey Fergie tractor in June. Thank you to all who made donations to Cancer Research UK. To date, we have raised £5300, a sum we never dreamed of when Chris first came up with the idea. It was particularly encouraging to see people on the day as we travelled down the dale between Keld and Reeth; thank you for your support.

#### Easier path in Swaledale.

Members of the Ragged Robin Conservation Group of volunteers have built their own 'Great Wall' at Healaugh to stop the well-worn path falling into the river. The work - done in conjunction with Yorkshire Dales National the Park Authority (YDNPA) - involved using 30 tonnes of stone to build the 40-metre-long wall to shore up the path and putting up a wire-link fence to hold the wall in place. Soil and grass sods were then laid back on the path surface. Ian Broadwith, Area Ranger for Swaledale and Arkengarthdale, said: "We were in imminent danger of losing the footpath to erosion by the river. This is a very popular walk along the banks of the River Swale and is used by many people who are doing the coast to coast. "Paths in this part of the dale provide excellent walks along both banks of the river. To lose them to erosion would have a huge impact on people's enjoyment of the area, so it is important that we try to hold on to them. The work also helped to protect the historic stone pitching on this section of riverbank that provides a solid surface leading down to the river's edge.

"This type of work is a method of revetment and it was chosen because there is a huge population of rabbits in the area. The other option would have been willow spiling which involves weaving and embedding willow shoots into the river bank, anchoring them with posts and allowing them to grow and form a natural defence wall. But I think the rabbits would have devoured the young willow shoots before they could establish themselves. "Revetment work of this type is expensive and takes many hours to complete. In the current economic climate, funding for this kind of work by the YDNPA will be more difficult so it is important for landowners and farmers to keep on top of the rabbit population. The rabbit warrens up and down the river banks have a destabilising effect on the banks because flood water gets in to them and then the whole area collapses and is lost to the river." Malcolm Petyt, the YDNPA's Member Champion for Recreation Management, said: "We can so easily under estimate the value of the work that volunteers can do to help preserve and improve this wonderful landscape for the enjoyment of others and this piece of work is a fitting tribute and testament to their skills and commitment to the work of the Yorkshire dales National Park Authority." The group, which includes some Dales Volunteers, works every week with Ian, who covers Swaledale and Arkengarthdale, and Access Ranger Paul Sheehan in Lower Wensleydale. Together they turn their hand to everything from coppicing to path maintenance - all for the love of the area and the opportunity to see it cared for.

#### Two fined over tree felling in National Park

Two men have been fined a total of £6.000 and ordered to pay £9,000 costs after being found guilty of breaching Preservation Order Yorkshire Dales National Park. Land agent Myles Metcalfe, 62, Ashes Farm, Hawes, appeared before Northallerton magistrates yesterday (June 20) along with contractor Douglas Atkin, 47, Skelton Hall, Marske, charged with breaches of the order in April last year when three trees were felled and a fourth was damaged. Metcalfe was convicted on all four charges, was fined £4,000 and was ordered to pay costs of £6,000. Atkin was also found quilty on all four counts. He was fined £2,000 and was ordered to pay costs of £3,000.

The case against labourer Robert Young, 21, Church Close, Redmire, was withdrawn by the Authority.

All three men denied all charges.

The court heard that the offences happened on land known as the Shearlings, south of an access road to the Brunt Acres Industrial Estate in Hawes.

The men were prosecuted by the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

Authority Planning Enforcement Officer Robert Bissicks said: "Trees are a vital part of the very special landscape in the National Park and they play a crucial role in its ecology. Many of them are protected, so it is important that landowners check before considering pruning or felling them. "We would always rather work with people to try to find a solution. Unfortunately, sometimes the Authority has to take this sort of legal action as a last resort."
