The travels of Lady Anne Clifford

Lady Anne Clifford, who was born in 1590, is one of the best documented women in the history of the north of England. By the time she died in 1676, aged 86, she had lived through the reigns of four monarchs and the Commonwealth. In addition to leaving copious records of her long life, her legacy in the landscape is there for all to see. June Hall's talk will cover her life story within its historical context, and will look at buildings associated with this remarkable woman. June Hall was resident in the Wensleydale area for thirty years and is the author of many local history

publications. She moved to Cumbria ten years ago and now lives near Lady Anne's last home, Brougham Castle, near Penrith. 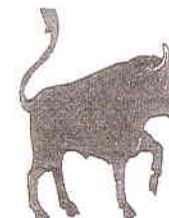

IMPROVING YOUR HEALTH

Often at this time of year, thoughts turn towards positive changes we would like to make in our lives. Some of those changes may involve improving our own health. Good intentions often fall by the wayside, consumed by the endless demands on our time. How often have we said to ourselves, 'I'm too busy to do....'. I am reminded of an old saying that, 'If you don't make time for your health now, you will be forced to make time for illness later'. Having seen many people through important changes in their lives, I'm convinced that the key is to make small, achievable changes rather than a radical overhaul. These small changes are more likely to become part of everyday life and therefore a positive habit.

At the practice, we are more than happy to help support you through changes, whether it is stopping smoking, losing weight or having more information about healthy diets. Many of you will have been offered NHS health checks at the practice as well as the various national screening programmes for cervical, breast and bowel cancer and aortic aneurysms, and I would encourage you to take these offers up. Last year we have seen several breast and bowel cancers detected in the early, treatable stages through the screening programmes.

Another area we hope to help patients with is medication reviews. Most people have their medication reviewed by the

doctor every six months or so. We would encourage you to let us know if you are no longer using medication or if you think that you are having side effects. It is quite depressing at times to see piles of unused medication returned to the dispensary after people have had a clear out - unfortunately it cannot be reused and ends up being destroyed. We are particularly interested in helping people who are taking sleeping tablets regularly. Tablets such as diazepam, temazepam and zopiclone tend to lose their effects after six weeks or so of taking them regularly. They are highly addictive and are associated with high risk of falls in older people and most recently there has been some research associating use of these tablets with developing dementia. There can be significant withdrawal effects if these are stopped suddenly, so if you are wanting to stop this type of medication, please see one of the doctors first to discuss - do not stop abruptly.

The February programme for helping improve everyday skills is focussing on making the best use of home computers. There will be two free introductory workshops on Monday 4th February from 10am till 12 noon and Friday 8th February from 1pm till 3pm, in the Meeting Room at Hudson House.

As well as a guidance talk on Computer Safety, the workshops will include an exploratory session to identify which areas of computer usage would be most beneficial for general interest. Examples of possible subjects would be Skype, using the Internet, e-mails, Word, Excel, and so on.

The subjects identified will then continue to be studied at practical sessions on Fridays 15th and 22nd of February and Friday 1st of March from 1pm till 3pm. There will be a £3 charge for attendance at each of these classes. We hope you will find the opening workshops and the continuing sessions to be valuable.

CRIME IN THE TWO DALES

As a road user (motorist or pedestrian), you will have a responsibility to yourself, your passengers and other road users. In the last few months there have been several road related incidents. Here are some suggestions as to what you can do to ensure a safe journey. Firstly consider whether your journey is necessary and obtain the latest weather information. When driving, travel slowly and at a safe distance from the vehicle in front to avoid harsh braking or steering. Always use dipped headlights when visibility is poor. Ensure your eyesight is up to the relevant standard. (have your eyes checked at least every 2 years). Plan your route and allow yourself extra time and travel on a main road that has been treated rather than use minor roads if possible. We have also received several reports in the last two months of possible suspect males and vehicles in the areas of Muker, Gunnerside and Healaugh, Ellerton Abbey and Marske. A quad bike was found abandoned in Fremington, one was stolen from Hudswell but later found and returned. Two quads were removed from properties in Reeth in an attempt to steal them and found, as was a 4x4 vehicle. At this time there were also two attempt burglaries on dwellings in Reeth but nothing taken. In Marske a Powershaft was removed from a vehicle and an attempt was made to steal a 4x4 from a dwelling in the area; in Arkengarthdale parcels were removed from an outbuilding; a metal sheep feeder was taken from moorland near Tan Hill; heating oil was stolen from a tank in Hudswell. We also received reports of three youths entering a storage building

and causing criminal damage to a nature reserve in Downholme they were found and dealt with accordingly. A suspect male was trying to sell door to door in Healaugh and there was a burglary committed in Healaugh over the festive season; a male was reported entering a property in Gunnerside uninvited. The message as always is to not tempt thieves by leaving vehicles or buildings insecure and to continue to report any suspicious persons or vehicles (preferably with registrations) if possible immediately. A Happy New Year to everyone from myself and my colleagues at Leyburn Police Station.

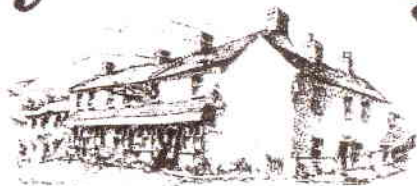

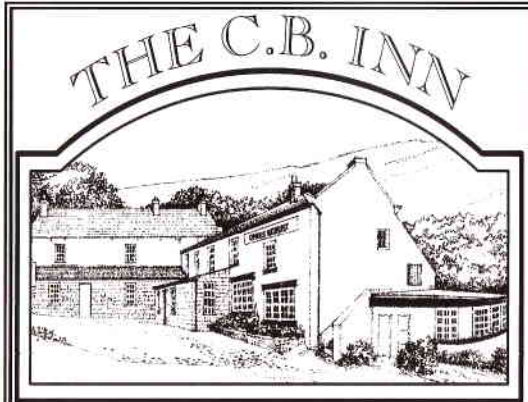

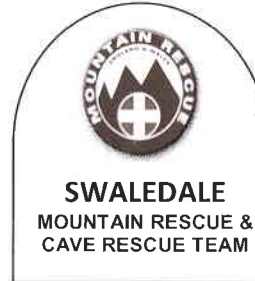

**PRINT & SCAN THE WORLD OVER
(AND OTHER STUPID THINGS)**

Someone sent me a link to a Dutch TV documentary over Christmas which I watched (with some subtitles and some head scratching, if you want to see it check out <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=okhfDsKmAoY> - it is mostly in English). This gave some quite worrying information about the new range of internet ready products appearing on the market and in particular the new range of printers, scanners and network storage. All of the manufacturers are making loud noises about making these devices easier to use in the home but also giving access to the devices from anywhere in the world. The idea is if you are away from home for work or on holiday and need a particular document you can quickly connect to your home network and grab the file you need or someone at home can put the document on the scanner and you can collect the scan wherever you might be. Sounds like a really neat idea, especially for business trips - right. Well yes and no. The problems arise because what the manufacturers don't tell you is that if you can access your files from anywhere in the world there is a good chance anybody else can too! The documentary shows how even large firms (such as KLM airlines) and public bodies (such as Europol - the European version of

Interpol) have been seriously compromised by these devices. Ironically the main issue is not with the devices themselves but the way manufacturers get you to set them up from new. To save lots of hassle from customer support they basically turn off all the security features so if you just grab the thing out of the box, plug it in and start using it you basically open the box to the world. You need to carefully go through all the security settings and add your own passwords to stop other people getting in. Common new devices with this problem are the new HP printers sporting the new ePrint system. This is designed to let you print easily from your tablet (iPad or Android) as well as print from anywhere or scan from anywhere. The security risk is that people who use scanners regularly forget to remove documents they have scanned. Surprisingly often these documents contain a lot of personal information that can be used by third parties to facilitate identity theft. So if you have a new printer/scanner or network attached storage device do please read the manual and check your security settings. One other stupid (actually criminal and really irritating) thing ... the scam I have mentioned many times before, where someone calls pretending to be from Microsoft and wants to fix a problem on your computer, seems to be going from strength to strength.

In the past I have seen this as more of an annoyance but over Christmas I was contacted by someone who had had over £500 stolen from their credit card by this scam. If someone you don't know calls you with an offer to help treat them the same way you would treat a stranger at the door demanding entry to your house to fix a faulty vacuum cleaner - ie. send them away with a flea in their ear. Just because someone says they are from Microsoft doesn't mean they are - it is very difficult to get anyone at MS to talk to you when you are prepared to pay so if they phone you it is absolutely a SCAM.
